**2001 ALL-CENTENNIAL WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM ANNOUNCED**  
**F&M Junior Guard Amy Kreitz Named Player of the Year**

**Lancaster, PA -- February 19, 2001** -- West Division co-champion Franklin & Marshall placed two players on the first team as the 2000-01 All-Centennial Conference women's basketball team was announced today.

Diplomat junior **Amy Kreitz (Allentown, PA / Salisbury)**, who leads the Conference in scoring (18.5), was a unanimous first-team All-CC selection and was named the 2001 Centennial Conference Player of the Year in balloting by the 11 head coaches. Kreitz, who is second in steals (3.57), fifth in three-point field goal percentage (39.7), and 10th in FT percentage (71.6) in the CC, is the first F&M player to earn Conference Player of the Year laurels. It was her second consecutive first-team All-CC nod.

Joining Kreitz in the first-team backcourt is junior teammate **Lauren Howanski (Gap, PA / Pequea Valley)**. Howanski, who suffered a torn ACL with five games remaining in the season, is third in the CC in scoring (17.1), second in assists (4.0) and third in FT percentage (76.3). She was a second-team All-Centennial pick last season. Dickinson senior **Kim Selemba (Scranton, PA / Bishop O'Hara)** rounds out the backcourt. She is second in the Conference in scoring (17.1) and closed her career with 1,575 points - good for second on the Dickinson and third on the Centennial career lists.

Swarthmore junior **Heather Kile (Marlton, NJ / Holy Cross)**, the 2000 Centennial Player of the Year, earned her third first-team All-CC nod, after leading the Garnet to its first-ever East Division title. She is fourth in the CC in scoring (16.0), third in rebounding (8.8) and FG percentage (50.4), and second in FT percentage (80.0). Kile becomes the fourth Centennial player to earn first-team All-Conference honors three times. Western Maryland senior **Jill Ibex (Westminster, MD / Westminster)** rounds out the elite quintet with her second straight first-team selection. She is sixth in the CC in scoring (15.9), eighth in rebounding (7.6) and second in blocked shots (2.04).

The Centennial Conference playoffs get underway Wednesday night at two sites. East Division champ Swarthmore (20-4) entertains West No. 2 seed Franklin & Marshall (17-6) at 7 p.m., while the West's top seed Johns Hopkins (16-8) welcomes Muhlenberg (14-10), the East runner-up, to Baltimore for a 7 p.m. tip. The winners will meet Saturday at a campus site to be determined. If the Garnet defeats F&M, the title game will be in Swarthmore. Otherwise, the championship tilt will be held at the winner of the Johns Hopkins-Muhlenberg game.
