Marissa Giorgio, Dickinson (Sr, GK, Rehersburg, PA / Tulpehocken) - Giorgio posted her fifth shutout of the season and tied a school record with the 15th blanking of her career in the 3-0 win over Villa Julie.

Kate Heintzelman, Franklin & Marshall (Sr, M, Mountaintop, PA / Crestwood) - Heintzelman had an assist on the Diplomats' lone goal in a 2-1 loss to Millersville.

Carrie Brown, Gettysburg (So, F, Hummelstown, PA / Hershey) - Brown had a goal and an assist in the Bullets' 1-1 week, including what proved to be the game-winning assist vs. Western Maryland.

Anya Goldberg, Haverford (So, GK, Ambler, PA / Penn Charter) - Goldberg, a first-season keeper, made 19 saves and allowed just three goals in the Fords' 0-2 week for a 86.4 save percentage.

Ashley Robbins, Johns Hopkins (Sr, F, Newtown Square, PA / Westtown School) - Robbins had a goal vs. Catholic and two vs. Bryn Mawr to take sole possession of 10th place on the Centennial career list with 34.

Melissa Eicken, Muhlenberg (Sr, M, Belmar, NJ / Manasquan) - Eicken's play in the midfield helped the Mules to a 28-6 shot advantage in the 2-0 triumph over Haverford.

Allison Gaffney, Swarthmore (Sr, F, Lewes, DE / Cape Henlopen) - Gaffney had a goal in the loss to Washington and the game-winning tally in the triumph over Dickinson.

Becky Arnold, Western Maryland (So, GK, Linwood, MD / Francis Scott Key) - Arnold registered her third shutout of the season in the 1-0 victory over Haverford.

Notes from around the Conference

FAST START: Washington's 3-2 victory over Swarthmore raised the Shorewomen's Conference record to 6-0 - the best Centennial start ever for the Washington program. Junior F **Julie Phillips (Easton, MD / Easton)** leads the Conference in scoring with 8-5-21.

CLOSING IN: Dickinson senior GK **Marissa Giorgio (Rehersburg, PA / Tulpehocken)** recorded a shutout vs. Villa Julie, raising her career total to 15 - tying the school record held by **Lara Znotens '98**. Gettysburg head coach **Carol Cantele** needs five more victories to become the program's all-time coaching victory leader, surpassing legendary coach **Grace Kenney**. She has a 115-66-1 record in 10 seasons.

ROAD TRIP: Johns Hopkins just completed a stretch of seven straight road games, compiling a 1-6 record. When the Blue Jays play host to Washington on Tuesday, it will be the first home game at Homewood Field in 32 days. Of course, after the match, JHU goes on the road for three more games, before wrapping up the regular season with three home tilts.

ON THEIR WAY: Johns Hopkins senior F **Ashley Robbins (Newtown Square, PA / Westtown School)** scored three goals last week, including a pair vs. Bryn Mawr, to take sole possession of 10th place on the Centennial career list with 34. She is three points shy of the No. 9 position on the Conference career chart with 34-16-84. Swarthmore senior F **Kim Cariello (Hudson, OH / Western Reserve Academy)** is also approaching the top 10 and the 30-goal club. She has 28 career tallies and needs two more to become just the 13th Centennial player to reach 30 goals for her career.

PREVIEWING THIS WEEK'S CENTENNIAL GAMES:

Bryn Mawr at Franklin & Marshall: The Diplomats hold a 6-0-2 series lead with six straight victories. The Mawrters battled F&M to draws in 1993 (1-1) and 1994 (0-0).

Washington at Johns Hopkins: The Blue Jays hold a 5-3 series lead on the Shorewomen since 1993 with wins in 1999 and 2000. Three of the last six games have gone into overtime.

Swarthmore at Muhlenberg: The Garnet have won seven straight games to take a 7-1 series lead since 1993. The Mules' lone win was a 2-1 triumph at home in 1993.

Dickinson at Bryn Mawr: The Red Devils are 7-1 against the Mawrters with wins in the last four outings. Bryn Mawr's lone victory was a 1-0 triumph in 1996 at Carlisle.

Franklin & Marshall at Western Maryland: This is the 26th meeting between the Diplomats and the Green Terror with F&M holding an 18-6-1 series advantage. The home team has won this matchup the past three seasons.

Muhlenberg at Gettysburg: This is the 11th meeting between the Mules and the Bullets since 1981 with Gettysburg holding an 8-2 advantage. Muhlenberg broke a six-game losing streak with a 3-1 victory at home last fall. The Mules' last win in Gettysburg was a 3-1 triumph in 1993.

Johns Hopkins at Swarthmore: The Blue Jays hold a slender 5-4 series lead on the Garnet since 1993 with wins in their last four games. Hopkins won twice last season, taking a 6-0 decision in the regular-season matchup and a 1-0 victory in the Conference championship game. Swat's last win was a 4-0 triumph at home in 1997.
