Notes from around the Conference

WRAPPED UP: Washington secured one of the four spots for the Conference's championship tournament on Oct. 27-28 with a 2-1 victory over two-time defending champion Johns Hopkins. Sophomore F **Taneil Sisco (Kent County, MD / Kent County)** scored both goals for the Shorewomen, who can lock up homefield advantage with a win at Gettysburg Saturday. Since a loss on Sept. 4, Washington is 12-2 with the only defeats coming at the hands of #1 Salisbury and #2 Rowan.

TIMELY: Washington junior midfielder **Jessica McAdams (Baltimore, MD / Bryn Mawr)** must not like playing in overtime games, because she scores quickly to end them. Back on Sept. 22, she scored 1:16 into extra time to defeat Muhlenberg, 1-0. Last Sunday, she wasted just 25 seconds before tallying an unassisted goal to finish off Roanoke, 3-2.

SIXTEEN ZEROES EQUAL 1: Dickinson senior GK **Marissa Giorgio (Rehersburg, PA / Tulpehocken)** recorded a shutout vs. Bryn Mawr, raising her career total to 16 - besting the school record of 15 held by **Lara Znotens '98**. The Red Devil offense also set a record with its 33rd goal of the season. The win assured Dickinson of its first winning season since 1994.

PUT AN EXTRA FIVE ON THE CLOCK: The last three times that Swarthmore has played at Muhlenberg, the Garnet has come away victorious in overtime.

NEVER BETTER: Western Maryland's 11 wins are the most that a Green Terror hockey squad has ever posted in the program's 53 seasons of varsity play.

CLOSING IN ON A LEGEND: Gettysburg head coach **Carol Cantele** needs three more victories to become the program's all-time coaching victory leader, surpassing legendary coach **Grace Kenney**. She has a 117-66-1 record in 10 seasons.

ON THEIR WAY: Johns Hopkins senior F **Ashley Robbins (Newtown Square, PA / Westtown School)** scored two goals last week to move within one goal of the No. 9 spot on the Centennial career list with 36. She has 36-16-88 for her career and needs 12 more points to become just the seventh Centennial player to reach the 100-point plateau. Swarthmore senior F **Kim Cariello (Hudson, OH / Western Reserve Academy)** is also approaching the top 10 and the 30-goal club. She has 29 career tallies and needs one more to become just the 13th Centennial player to reach 30 goals for her career.

PREVIEWING THIS WEEK'S CENTENNIAL GAMES:

Dickinson at Muhlenberg: This is the 20th meeting between the Red Devils and the Mules in a series that began in 1982. Muhlenberg holds an 11-7-1 advantage. Dickinson has won two of the last three in Allentown (1995-97), but the Mules took a 2-0 decision at home in 1999.

Gettysburg at F&M: This is the 34th time that the Diplomats and the Bullets have played since 1973. F&M leads the series, 16-14-3, but has not defeated Gettysburg since a 2-1 OT triumph on the road in 1993. The Orange and Blue has taken four straight at Baker Campus.

Johns Hopkins at W. Maryland: The Blue Jays hold a 6-2 series lead since 1993 and are 2-2 in Westminster. WMC took a 1-0 OT decision at home in 1999.

Bryn Mawr at W. Maryland: The Mawrters have caused problems for the Green Terror since 1993, winning four times including two of the last three games. WMC captured a 4-0 decision last season.

Haverford at Dickinson: The Red Devils hold a 6-2 lead in the series that began in 1993. Three of the five games have gone to OT with Dickinson winning all three. The Fords won the last meeting in Carlisle in 1999 (1-0).

F&M at Swarthmore: This is the 12th time that F&M and Swarthmore have met on the hockey field with the Garnet holding a 7-3-1 series lead. The Dips captured a 2-1 decision last year at home to break Swat's five-year win streak. The Garnet has won all four home games since 1993.

Washington at Gettysburg: The Bullets hold a 6-2 lead in the series since 1993, but the Shorewomen broke Gettysburg's five-year win streak with a 3-1 triumph at the Battlefield last season.

Muhlenberg at Johns Hopkins: The Blue Jays have won five straight in the series to take an 8-1 lead since 1993. Hopkins won both meetings last season, winning 4-3 on the road in the regular-season game and 1-0 at home in the Conference semifinals. The Mules' lone win was a 2-1 OT victory at home in 1996.
