WMC, MULES PLACE 13 PLAYERS ON ALL-CENTENNIAL FOOTBALL FIRST TEAM Harris Repeats as Offensive Player of Year; Wingart Takes Defensive Honor

LANCASTER, Pa. -- November 12, 2001 -- Muhlenberg and Western Maryland, which shared the Centennial championship, placed 13 players on the 2001 All-Centennial Conference Football first team which was announced today.

Green Terror senior QB **Jamie "Boo" Harris (Sarasota, FL / Riverview)** was named the Conference's Offensive Player of the Year. Western Maryland senior DB **Jason Wingart (Sparks, MD / Hereford)** was selected as the Conference's Defensive Player of the Year. The balloting was conducted by the seven head coaches.

Harris, a unanimous choice as first-team quarterback, repeats as the Conference's Offensive Player of the Year. He led the Conference in pass efficiency (168.0) and total offense (2,251 yards). Harris finished as No. 1 on the Centennial's all-time list for rushing yards by a QB (1,892 yards), No. 7 for career touchdown passes (40) and No. 8 in total offense (5,330 yards).

Wingart, also a unanimous choice for the first team backfield, led the Green Terror and the Conference with eight interceptions. He registered 60 tackles on the season to earn his second straight first-team nod. Wingart is the third consecutive WMC defender to earn Player of the Year honors, following in the footsteps of Tommy Selecky (1999) and Aaron Bartolain (2000).

Western Maryland, which won its fifth straight Centennial title, placed seven players on the first team, seven on the second team and three received honorable mention. Senior WR **Teron Powell (Milford, DE / Sussex Tech)** was a unanimous first-team choice, after leading the CC with 14 touchdown receptions. Junior OL **Nick Alevrogiannis (Timonium, MD / St. Paul's)** and junior LB **Matt Wilchinski (Glastonbury, CT / Bridgton Academy)** joined Harris and Powell as unanimous selections. Alevrogiannis anchored an offensive line that led the Terror to 428.6 yards and 41.3 points per game. Wilchinski, who repeated as a first-team choice, was second on the team with 67 tackles. Senior DL **Josh Galemore (Spring Grove, PA / South Western)** and senior LB **Athan Margetas (York, PA / West York)** also earned first-team recognition.

Muhlenberg, which won its first Conference championship since 1986, had seven players on the first team, 10 on the second team and one receive honorable mention recognition. Senior KR **Joshua Carter (Mt. Vernon, NY / Rye Country Day)** joined an elite group of players who have been named first-team All-Centennial three times, after leading the CC in punt return average (12.7) and placing third in kickoff return average (24.1). Twenty-six players have been three-time first-team All-Conference honorees since 1983. Carter also repeated as a first-team wide receiver. Sophomore RB **Matt Bernardo (Lebanon Twp., NJ / Voorhees)**, senior TE **Mike Stankowitz (Westwood, NJ / Westwood Regional)**, senior OL **Joe Muccia (Cranford, NJ / Cranford)**, junior LB **Beau Sherry (Haddon Twp., NJ / Haddon Twp.)** and senior DB **Erik Hammar (Long Valley, NJ / West Morris Central)** also were named to the first unit. Bernardo was second in the CC with 1,038 rushing yards and 19 TDs. Stankowitz and Sherry were unanimous choices, while Hammar was second in the Conference with seven interceptions.

Johns Hopkins senior WR **Zach Baylin (Wilmington, DE / Tatnall School)** led the Conference in receptions for the third straight season (58) to earn first-team All-CC laurels. Ursinus senior RB **Shearrod Duncan (Amityville, NY / Holy Trinity)** joined Harris and Bernardo in the first team backfield after rushing for a school-record 1,747 yards and scoring 23 TDs. Junior center **Brian McArdle (Levittown, PA / Harry S. Truman)** was one of the anchors of the Bear offensive line and earned his second straight first-team nod. Johns Hopkins junior OL **Kevin Kostibos (Florham Park, NJ / Hanover Park)** and Dickinson freshman **Scott Blum (Howell, NJ / Howell)** round out the first-team interior line. Blum helped the Red Devils lead the CC in rushing offense (253.1). Blue Jay senior PK **Matt Andrade (Wyoming, DE / Caesar Rodney)** was named to the first team, after setting a Conference record with 27 straight extra-point conversions.

Johns Hopkins senior **Erich Hellmold (Sayville, NY / Sayville)** was a unanimous selection on the defensive line. He anchored a Blue Jay defense that led the Conference in scoring (14.0) and total defense (247.7). Dickinson senior **Keith Fischer (Far Hills, NJ / Bernards)** earned his third straight first-team nod, becoming the 27th player in Conference history to turn the trick. Ursinus senior **Paul Schmidt (Remensburg, NY / Westhampton Beach)** rounds out the quartet after leading the Conference with 11 sacks.

Joining Sherry, Wilchinski and Margetas on the linebacking corps is Gettysburg senior **Ryan Moore (Glenolden, PA / Interboro)**, who led the Conference with 114 tackles and closed his career as the CC's all-time leader in the category (430). Ursinus senior **Mike Dale (Southampton, PA / Archbishop Wood)** and Dickinson junior **Mike Jackowski (Pottstown, PA / Pottstown)** join Wingart and Hammar in the backfield. Dale had six interceptions, broke up 16 passes, and led the CC in kickoff return average (24.4). Franklin & Marshall senior **Mark Rowand (York, PA / Dallastown)** led the Conference with a 39.6 yard punting average to receive the first-team selection.

Two Centennial teams will participate in postseason play. Western Maryland will travel to Washington & Jefferson for a first-round NCAA playoff game on Saturday, Nov. 17. Muhlenberg will take on King's in Wilkes-Barre in an ECAC playoff game on Saturday.
