## Offensive Player of the Week

**Matt Bernardo, Muhlenberg**  
 Sophomore, RB, 5-9, 197  
 Lebanon Township, NJ (Voorhees HS)

Bernardo rushed for 187 yards on 28 carries in Muhlenberg's 45-3 win at Franklin & Marshall, tying school records for rushing TDs in a game (4) and career (25) - in just the 14th game of his career. Bernardo also became the 20th player in team history to surpass the 1,000-yard mark for a career.

## Honor Roll

**Antonio Tiberi, Dickinson** (Jr, RB, Hockessin, DE / Archmere Academy) - Tiberi rushed for 106 yards on just seven carries, including a 71-yard scoring run in the fourth period vs. Albright.

**Steve Linebaugh, Franklin & Marshall** (Sr, PK, 6-0, 176, York, PA / Central York) - Linebaugh booted a 27-yard field goal in the second period for the Diplomats' lone points vs. Muhlenberg.

**Pete Vincelli, Gettysburg** (Jr, HB, 5-10, 170, Oceanport, NJ / Shore Regional) - Vincelli set a career high with three touchdowns in the win over Averett. He rushed eight times for 38 yards, scoring on runs of three, 10 and three yards.

**Adam Cook, Johns Hopkins** (Fr, RB, 5-8, 185, New Freedom, PA / Susquehannock) - Cook had an impressive showing in his first career start, carrying 18 times for 120 yards and amassing 172 all-purpose yards vs. Bridgewater.

**Chris Glowacki, Ursinus** (Sr, WR, Spring City, PA / Penn Charter) - Glowacki hauled in six passes for 75 yards, including an 8-yarder for a touchdown vs. Western Maryland.

**Jemel Johnson, Western Maryland** (Jr, RB, 6-2, 200, New Castle, DE / Hodgson Tech) - Johnson carried 16 times for 70 yards, including a 20-yard TD run vs. Ursinus.

## Defensive Player of the Week

**Joe Rydzewski, Western Maryland**  
 Junior, DL, 6-2, 252  
 Gaithersburg, MD (Gaithersburg HS)

Rydzewski led a Green Terror defense with eight tackles, including two for losses, and a sack in the 35-9 win over Ursinus. The WMC defensive front helped limit the Bears to just 32 rushing yards.

**Ryan Moore, Gettysburg** (Sr, LB, 5-11, 200, Glenolden, PA / Interboro) - Moore had seven tackles, forced a fumble, and returned an interception for a touchdown vs. Averett. It set a CC record for interception returns for TDs in a season (3, tied) and career (5).

**Justin Saverine, Muhlenberg** (Fr, P, 5-9, 190, Wilton, CT / Wilton) - Saverine, making his varsity debut, punted six times for a 43.8-yard average vs. F&M. His first two punts were downed at the Dips' 5 and 2-yard line, respectively.

**Mike Dale, Ursinus** (Sr, DB, Southampton, PA / Archbishop Wood) - Dale registered four tackles, forced a fumble and recovered another vs. Western Maryland.

## ***Team-by-Team Notes from around the Conference***

**DICKINSON (1-3, 0-1):** lost to Albright, 27-12. *Next Week:* idle.

The Red and White dropped its third straight game after a season-opening win. Dickinson fumbled three times and threw a pair of interceptions that led the a pair of Albright TDs. The Red Devil ground game was clicking, amassing 223 yards in the second half and 266 overall. Junior RB **Antonio Tiberi (Hockessin, DE / Archmere Academy)** ran for 106 yards and scored on a 71-yard scamper, while senior **Mike Smith (Bangor, PA / Bangor)** rushed for 91 yards. Junior **Mike Jackowski (Pottstown, PA / Pottstown)** and senior **Keith Fischer (Far Hills, NJ / Bernards)** each had a game-high 12 tackles. Junior LB **Trent Stumbaugh (Chambersburg, PA / Chambersburg)** had eight tackles and a blocked FG, which turned into Dickinson points after Tiberi's 71-yard run. Freshman QB **Keven Williams (Turnersville, NJ / Washington Twp.)** saw significant action in place of injured **Isaac Custer (Annville, PA / Annville-Cleona)**.

**FRANKLIN & MARSHALL (1-3, 0-2):** lost to Muhlenberg, 45-3. *Next Week:* Carnegie Mellon.

F&M saw its Centennial losing streak hit nine games with its loss to the Mules. Muhlenberg has outscored the Diplomats, 132-16, in the last three contests. The Blue also lost the services of its top two QBs, as junior **Dave Makson (Wilton, CT / Wilton)** suffered a high ankle sprain and sophomore **Doug Hiltner (Margate, NJ / Atlantic City)** suffered clavicle. Senior PK **Steve Linebaugh (York, PA / Central York)** booted a 27-yard FG for the team's lone points. Sophomore RB **Chris Richards (Jenkintown, PA / Lawrenceville)** averaged 24.8 yards on four kick returns. Junior TE **Matt Wagaman (Lititz, PA / Warwick)** had his second straight seven-catch game for 68 yards, giving him 20 for 273 yards on the season - good for 2nd in the CC. Sophomore DB **Jay Tressler (Herndon, PA / Line Mountain)** had a pair of interceptions, while soph DT **Cornelius George (Hershey, PA / Milton Hershey)** led the defense with nine tackles, including six solo stops. F&M has just three wins in its last 24 games - the first time that has happened since the 1960-61-62 seasons.

**GETTYSBURG (2-2, 0-1):** d. Averett, 61-6. *Next Week:* Johns Hopkins.

The Orange and Blue's 55-point margin of victory was the program's largest since a 62-7 win over Dickinson in 1984, while the 61 points represented the most since a 64-15 triumph over Swarthmore in 1997. In addition, Gettysburg snapped a seven-game road losing streak, winning away from Musselman Stadium for the first time since Oct. 30, 1999, when the Bullets defeated St. Lawrence, 59-28. The Gettysburg Wing-T was in high gear, rolling up 395 rushing yards, led by freshman HB **Mike Lublanecki (Long Valley, NJ / West Morris Central)** who ran for 112 on 13 carries for his second straight century-breaking performance. He is third in the CC with 397 yards. Junior HB **Pete Vincelli (Oceanport, NJ / Shore Regional)** scored a career-best three TDs, becoming the first Bullet to turn the trick since Paul Smith scored six times vs. Muhlenberg in 1999. He also threw a 32-yard pass on a HB option play. Sophomore HB **Gentris Bryant (Wilmington, DE / Archmere Academy)** carried 14 times for a career-high 65 yards and his first collegiate TD. A week after becoming the Conference's all-time leading tackler, senior LB **Ryan Moore (Glenolden, PA / Interboro)** set another Centennial mark with his 36-yard interception return for a score. It is his third TD return of a theft on the season - tying the 18-year-old mark set by WMC's **Rick Conner** in 1983 - and the fifth of his career, establishing a CC standard. It was one of five Gettysburg picks, as sophomore S **Chris Jordan (Bethesda, MD / Gonzaga)** had two interceptions and freshman **Campbell Henry (Chapel Hill, NC / Episcopal)** returned his first collegiate theft 71 yards for a touchdown on the game's final play.

**JOHNS HOPKINS (2-1, 0-0):** lost to Bridgewater, 50-27. *Next Week:* at Gettysburg.

Hopkins failed in its attempt to go 3-0 for the first time since 1967, but not without a fight as the Blue Jays gave third-ranked Bridgewater all it could handle. JHU rolled up 478 yards of total offense on a school-record 91 offensive plays. Freshman RB **Adam Cook (New Freedom, PA / Susquehannock)**, playing in place of injured **Scott Martorana (Long Valley, NJ / West Morris Central)** and **Kevin Johnson (Baltimore, MD / City)**, ran for 120 yards on just 18 carries. Senior QB **Rob Heleniak (Philadelphia, PA / Germantown Academy)** threw for 247 yards and a pair of touchdowns and is now tied for sixth on the JHU career TD list (24). Senior WR **Zach Baylin (Wilmington, DE / Tatnall School)** reached the 150-catch plateau for his career, snagging seven balls for 57 yards. Sophomore WR **Jason Lehman (Manheim, PA / Manheim Central)** had a career-high four catches for 80 yards and a touchdown. Senior PK **Matt Andrade (Wyoming, DE / Caesar Rodney)** booted FGs of 36 and 27 yards, becoming just the second Blue Jay kicker to amass 100 career points (104).

**MUHLENBERG (3-1, 2-0):** d. Franklin & Marshall, 45-3. *Next Week:* Western Maryland.

The Mules went back in time to 1968 with its road win at F&M. It is the first time in 33 years that 'Berg has won back-to-back games by 40+ points, while the 92 points in the last two contests in the most since 1968. Sophomore RB **Matt Bernardo (Lebanon Twp., NJ / Voorhees)** rushed for 187 yards and scored four TDs vs. the Dips, tying school records for rushing TDs in a game and career (25). In just 14 career games, he has 25 rushing TDs and 1,156 yards. Senior WR/KR **Joshua Carter (Mt. Vernon, NY / Rye Country Day)** was held without a reception, but was not held in check, as he set a school record with 154 yards on eight punt returns. Senior DB **Sergio Masvidal (Miami, FL / Belen Jesuit Prep)** recorded his first career interception - one of three on the day for the defense. Freshman P **Justin Saverine (Wilton, CT / Wilton)** averaged 43.8 yards on six punts with a long of 55 yards. His first two collegiate kicks were downed inside the F&M five. Senior **Joe Buglione (N. Haledon, NJ / Worcester Academy, MA)** leads the CC with six sacks.

**URSINUS (2-2, 1-1):** lost at Western Maryland, 35-9. *Next Week:* idle.

The Bears came the Green Terror a scare, trailing 14-9 in the third period, before succumbing in Westminster. Down 14-0 at half, UC struck twice in 2:22 on an eight-yard pass from junior QB **Chris Rahill (Philadelphia, PA / Penn Charter)** to junior WR **Chris Glowacki (Philadelphia, PA / Penn Charter)** and a 25-yard FG by freshman **Ryan Regensberg (Pottstown, PA / Pottstown)**. But WMC responded with 21 fourth-period points in a 5:18 span to put the game away. Senior RB **Shearrod Duncan (Amityville, NY / Holy Trinity)** carried 31 times for a tough 79 yards. He still leads the CC in rushing with 592 yards (148 ypg). Rahill completed 16 of 29 passes for 194 yards, while Glowacki snared six balls for 75 yards. Glowacki has the CC lead with 24 receptions. Sophomore LB **Thomas Reilly (Philadelphia, PA / Penn Charter)** led the defense with 11 tackles, as the Bears held the Terror to 259 total yards. Junior **Jon Craig (Coraopolis, PA / West Allegheny)** leads the CC with 11 tackles for loss.

**WESTERN MARYLAND (3-1, 2-0):** d. Ursinus, 35-9. *Next Week:* at Muhlenberg.

The Green Terror machine keeps rolling, as WMC made it 30 Conference wins in a row with its victory over Ursinus. Junior DB **Mike Geneas (Leesburg, VA / Loudon)** got the Green on the board first with a 30-yard return of an interception for a score. Junior RB **Jemel Johnson (New Castle, DE / Hodgson Tech)** scored the first of two TDs on the day on a 1-yard run to make it 14-0 in the second period. He also tallied on a 20-yard run to end the scoring. Leading 14-9 with senior QB **Boo Harris (Sarasota, FL / Riverview)** on the sidelines with a hamstring injury, backup QB **John Luster (Sykesville, MD / South Carroll)** threw an 18-yard scoring pass to senior WR **Teron Powell (Milford, DE / Sussex Tech)** to make it a 12-point game. Moments later, senior **Chris Hamilton (Germantown, MD / Seneca Valley)** blocked a punt which was recovered by junior **Matt Miller (Hummelstown, PA / Lower Dauphin)** in the endzone. Luster completed seven of 15 passes for 65 yards, while running eight times for 42 yards. He is second in the CC in pass efficiency (132.5), trailing only Harris (184.0). Senior P **Kevin Culbertson (Baltimore, MD / Gilman School)** leads the Conferenc with a 39.3 yard average.

## This Week in the Centennial Conference

**SHOWDOWN IN ALLENTOWN:** Simply put, this game could be for the Centennial championship. Four-time defending champion Western Maryland brings its 30-game Conference win streak to Allentown to take on high-flying Muhlenberg at Scotty Wood Stadium. The Terror is 6-0-1 against the Mules since a 29-27 loss on the road in 1993. The lone blemish in the seven games was a 13-13 draw in Allentown in 1995.

**RECORD-SETTING THIEF:** Gettysburg senior LB **Ryan Moore (Glenolden, PA / Interboro)** set a Conference record when he returned an interception for a touchdown for the fifth time. His 36-yard return v. Averett was his third of the season - equaling the CC standard set by **Rick Conner** of Western Maryland in 1983.

**ALMOST A RECORD:** Muhlenberg's 92 points in its first two Centennial games is just two points shy of the Conference record for most points in the opening two CC games. Johns Hopkins amassed 94 points in wins over Swarthmore (42-0) and Gettysburg (52-13) in 1998.

**18 YEARS AND COUNTING:** In the 18-year history of the Centennial Conference, no team has lost its opening Centennial game and gone onto win the Conference championship. If history holds true to form, the race is down to four teams - Muhlenberg, Ursinus, Western Maryland and Johns Hopkins. The Blue Jays open Centennial play on Sept. 29 vs. Gettysburg.

**OUT OF CONFERENCE:** Gettysburg's 61-6 win over Averett and Dickinson's 27-12 loss to Albright brought the Centennial Conference's out-of-conference record to 9-7 on the year. Last season, the Conference was 15-13 against non-Centennial foes.

**WEEKEND GAMES:** Gettysburg welcomes Johns Hopkins to Musselman Stadium for the Jays' Conference opener. The Bullets hold an 18-8-2 series advantage, but Hopkins has won the last six meetings, including a 54-13 decision last fall in Baltimore. Gettysburg's last win was a 27-24 thriller at Homewood Field in 1994. Since the inception of the CC, the Bullets have had success in Baltimore, winning five of nine games.
