For the second time this season, Duncan and Powell share the Conference's weekly honor. Duncan, the nation's leading rusher, ran for 254 yards and three TDs, while also catching three passes for 89 yards and another score in the Bears' 53-14 win over Wooster. He became the school's career leader in rushing touchdowns (28), while his 343 all-purpose yards were the second-highest single-game total in school history. Powell caught seven passes for 138 yards and two TDs in the Green Terror's 54-0 win over Franklin & Marshall. He became the school's career leader in receptions (138) and the Conference's all-time leader in TD catches (34).

Keven Williams, Dickinson (Fr, QB, 5-11, 212, Turnersville, NJ / Washington Twp.) - Williams ran for a career-high 109 yards and scored on runs of 53 and 32 yards vs. Kean.

Justin Jones, Muhlenberg (Jr, QB, 5-11, 186, Bloomingdale, NJ / Pompton Lakes) - Jones rushed for 91 yards and set a school record for QBs with three rushing touchdowns vs. Gettysburg. He also passed for 125 yards and a score.

Skarpetowski and Galemore were the leaders of defenses that held opponents under 200 yards and kept them off the scoreboard. Skarpetowski had 12 tackles, including three for losses, and broke up two passes as the Mules held Gettysburg to 151 total yards in a 41-0 win. Galemore had 10 tackles, including six solo stops, as the Terror limited F&M to just 156 yards in a 54-0 triumph.

Bob Hess, Dickinson (Fr, LB, Annville, PA / Annville-Cleona) - Hess, making his first collegiate start, led the Devils with nine tackles (five solo) vs. Kean.

Mark Rowand, Franklin & Marshall (Sr, P/OT, York, PA / Dallastown) - Rowand averaged 45.5 yards on 10 punts, including a career-best 56-yard effort, vs. Western Maryland.

Cliff Mason, Gettysburg (Jr, OLB, 5-10, 176, Greenville, PA / Greenville) - Mason tied for the team lead with nine tackles vs. Muhlenberg, including six solo hits, while also forcing a fumble.

Eric Shipe, Ursinus (So, S, 6-0, 180, Reading, PA / Wilson) - Shipe picked off a pair of passes, including one he returned for a 53-yard touchdown, vs. Wooster. He also added six tackles and broke up four passes.

Team-by-Team Notes from around the Conference

DICKINSON (3-4, 1-2): d. Kean, 17-7. *Next Week:* Johns Hopkins.

The Red Devils went on the road for a Saturday night tilt and came away with a win over Kean of the New Jersey Athletic Conference. Freshman QB **Keven Williams (Turnersville, NJ / Washington Twp.)** carried nine times for a career-high 109 yards and a pair of TDs, covering 53 and 32 yards. In head coach **Darwin Breaux's** nine years at Dickinson, when a Devil back rushes for 100 yards, the Red and White is 35-3. The Devils are also 49-1 under Breaux when taking a lead into the fourth quarter. Another pair of rookies had big contributions, as LB **Bob Hess (Annville, PA / Annville-Cleona)**, making his first career start, led the defense with nine tackles, while PK **Drew Magyar (Morrisville, PA / Pennsylvania)** booted a 19-yard FG that put Dickinson up for good at 10-7. The Devils ran the ball right at the Cougars all night, running 55 times on 56 offensive plays. Junior TB **Antonio Tiberi (Hockessin, DE / Archmere Academy)** carried 14 times for 63 yards. Juniors **Mike Jackowski (Pottsville, PA / Pottsville)** and **Andy Kerstetter (Camp Hill, PA / Cedar Cliff)** each had an interception. Dickinson needs two wins in its final three games to secure its 15th straight non-losing season.

FRANKLIN & MARSHALL (1-7, 0-4): lost at Western Maryland, 54-0. *Next Week:* idle.

The Diplomats are looking forward to the week off, after falling to their second straight 2000 NCAA playoff participant. Two weeks ago, it was Hobart recording a 44-0 win over F&M. Last week, it was Western Maryland handing the Blue a 54-0 defeat. The back-to-back shutouts mark the first time since 1962 that F&M has failed to score points in consecutive games. The bright spot for the Diplomats in Westminster was senior OT/P **Mark Rowand (York, PA / Dallastown)**, who averaged 45.5 yards on 10 punts, including a career-long 56-yarder. Rowand is averaging 38.9 yards on 62 kicks this season. Senior FB **Daryl Black (Broad Top, PA / Tussey Mountain)** leads the team with 189 rushing yards, while junior QB **Dave Makson (Wilton, CT / Wilton)** has thrown for 663 yards and three scores. Junior TE **Matt Wagaman (Lititz, PA / Warwick)** has pulled in 37 passes for 544 yards and two TDs to lead the receiving corps. Sophomore LB **Andy Rehring (State College, PA / State College)** leads F&M with 76 tackles.

GETTYSBURG (2-5, 0-4): lost to Muhlenberg, 41-0. *Next Week:* at St. Lawrence.

The Bullets' four-game home win streak against Muhlenberg came to an end, as the Mules won by a 41-0 count for the second straight season. The Orange and Blue had not been shut out in successive seasons by an opponent since Kings Point turned the trick in 1995 (25-0) and 1996 (16-0). Gettysburg struggled on offense, gaining just 151 total yards and converting just three-of-20 third-down opportunities. Sophomore QB **Gavin Beier (Levittown, PA / Conwell-Egan Catholic)** completed 16 of 42 passes for just 94 yards. Junior LB **Cliff Mason (Greenville, PA / Greenville)** led the defense with nine tackles and forced his third fumble in two games. Sophomore DB **Matt Zangrilli (Wallingford, PA / Strath Haven)** recorded his first interception of the season. Senior LB **Ryan Moore (Glenolden, PA / Interboro)** is just five tackles shy of 400 for his career. Freshman RB **Mike Lublanecki (Long Valley, NJ / West Morris Central)** leads the team with 506 rushing yards. The Bullets hope to break out of their offensive funk when they visit Canton, N.Y. and St. Lawrence. On their last trip to the North Country, Gettysburg scored 59 points and rolled up a Conference-record 733 yards of total offense.

JOHNS HOPKINS (4-2, 2-1): idle. *Next Week:* at Dickinson.

The Blue Jays were idle last week. Hopkins looks for its win first at Biddle Field since 1985 (24-0) this week against Dickinson.

MUHLENBERG (5-2, 4-1): d. Gettysburg, 41-0. *Next Week:* Ursinus.

The Mules clinched their fourth straight non-losing season with its second straight 41-0 shutout of Gettysburg. The last time that Muhlenberg shut out an opponent in two consecutive years was 1956-57, when Scranton was the victim, while the last time that 'Berg had four straight non-losing seasons was 1986-89. Junior QB **Justin Jones (Bloomingtondale, NJ / Pompton Lakes)** rushed for 91 yards and set a school record for rushing TDs by a QB with three consecutive fourth-quarter scores. Sophomore RB **Matt Bernardo (Lebanon Twp., NJ / Voorhees)** gained a game-high 164 yards and set another school record with his 17th touchdown of the season. He is one rushing TD shy of the Conference single-season record of 18. Senior **Joshua Carter (Mt. Vernon, NY / Rye Country Day)** broke his own school record for punt return yards in a season (460) and became the second player in team history to amass 2,500 career receiving yards. The defense allowed Gettysburg just 49 total yards and one first down in the first half. Senior LB **Jon-Paul Skarpetowski (West Windsor, NJ / Peddie School)** led the way with 12 tackles, while junior DB **Bo Rodrigues (Palmerton, PA / Palmerton)** made seven stops and returned an interception 54 yards. Head coach **Mike Donnelly (26-22)** moved past legendary head coach **Ben Schwartzwalder (25-5, 1946-48)** into fifth place on the Muhlenberg career coaching victory chart.

URSINUS (4-3, 2-2): d. Wooster, 53-14. *Next Week:* at Muhlenberg.

The Bears posted 26 second-quarter points on their way to an easy 53-14 rout of Wooster of the North Coast Athletic Conference. Senior RB **Shearrod Duncan (Amityville, NY / Holy Trinity)** was the man once again, rushing 38 times for 254 yards and scoring three TDs on runs of five, 59 and 66 yards. He also caught three passes for 89 yards, giving him 343 all-purpose yards - good for second on the UC single-game chart. Duncan, who leads Division III in rushing, is now averaging 180.4 yards per game (1,263 yards). Junior QB **Chris Rahill (Philadelphia, PA / Penn Charter)** also had a big day, throwing for 253 yards and a pair of scores. He connected with senior WR **Josh Barr (West Chester, PA / Cardinal O'Hara)** on a 66-yard scoring strike and Duncan on a 15-yard TD pass. Sophomore **Eric Shipe (Reading, PA / Wilson)** opened the scoring by returning an interception 53 yards for a touchdown. Classmate **Matt Wallick (Bristol, PA / Truman)** scored a touchdown by recovering a blocked punt in the end zone. The UC defense held the Scots to minus-40 yards rushing, recording five sacks. Senior **Mark Hineman (West Chester, PA / Unionville)** registered a team-high eight tackles with a sack and a recovered fumble.

WESTERN MARYLAND (7-1, 5-0): d. Franklin & Marshall, 54-0. *Next Week:* idle.

The Green Terror clinched at least a tie for its fifth consecutive Conference football title with a convincing 54-0 win over visiting F&M. Senior QB **Boo Harris (Sarasota, FL / Riverview)** completed 10 of 14 passes for 162 yards and three TDs, while rushing for another score. Senior WR **Teron Powell (Milford, DE / Sussex Tech)** was on the receiving end of two of those TD tosses, covering 16 and 74 yards. The 74-yarder was the 34th six-point reception of his career, setting a Centennial record. Junior **Scots Crowell (Brinkow, MD / Sherwood)** ran 10 times for a game-high 100 yards and scored on runs of 17 and 22 yards, as WMC rolled up 325 yards on the ground. Senior SS **Jason Wingeart (Sparks, MD / Hereford)** picked off his eighth pass of the season - one shy of the school single-season record. His 15 career thefts is third on the Terror career list.

HOPKINS LOOKS TO KEEP TITLE HOPES ALIVE AT DICKINSON: The Blue Jays need wins over Dickinson and Franklin & Marshall to set up a shot at its first-ever Conference championship against Western Maryland on Nov. 10. This is the 55th meeting between Hopkins and Dickinson with JHU holding a slender 26-24-2 series advantage since 1891. The Red Devils have won the last four in the series and have not lost at Biddle Field since 1985 (24-0).

MULES CLOSE CC SCHEDULE vs. BEARS: Muhlenberg brings down the curtain on the Conference portion of the 2001 schedule against Ursinus. A 'Berg win, combined with a Western Maryland loss to Johns Hopkins on Nov. 10, will get the Mules a share of the Conference title for the first time since 1988. It is the 65th meeting between Muhlenberg and Ursinus in a series that dates to 1900. The Mules lead the series, 34-23-7, but the Bears have won five of the last seven meetings. Ursinus has won the last three games in Allentown and the road team has won five of the last six matchups.
