Dickinson

The Red Devils' three-game win streak was snapped at Washington & Lee ... **C Tom Lesczynski (West Babylon, NY / St. Anthony)** scored 29 points with 13 rebounds and five blocks in the win at Lancaster Bible ... he also had 18 vs. W&L, continuing a five-game streak as the team's leading scorer ... Lesczynski hit 19-of-32 shots from the floor (59.4 percent).

Franklin & Marshall

The Diplomats bounced back from a heart-breaking overtime loss at Lebanon Valley to defeat Juniata ... **F Derek Hines (Lancaster, PA / Manheim Twp.)** scored 22 points in the loss to LVC ... it was the 100th anniversary game with the Dutchmen in a series that began in 1907 ... **Clay Scovill (Lititz, PA / Manheim Twp.)** registered his first collegiate double-double with 15 points and 10 boards vs. the Eagles.

Gettysburg

The Bullets are 3-0 for the first time since 2003-04 following a win at York ... **G Dan Capkin (Wynnewood, PA / Lower Merion)** scored 24 points and tied a career high with six assists, while **F Corey Dorsey (Frederick, MD / St. John's at Prospect Hall)** added 21 ... Capkin is averaging 27.3 ppg. and has scored at least 24 points in all three games ... **C Andrew Powers (Boyertown, PA / Boyertown)** recorded his first collegiate double-double with 12 points and 11 boards.

Haverford

The Fords went 0-3 last week with road losses to Catholic and Carnegie Mellon, followed by a neutral court loss to Susquehanna ... **F Ray Panek (Brooklyn, NY / Regis)** scored a career-high 13 points vs. the Cardinals ... **G Chaz Thomas (Huntington, NY / Wyandanch Memorial)** scored a career-best 29 markers vs. the Tartans, including four triples ... Haverford had trouble closing out games, losing an eight-point lead with 8:47 left to Catholic and an 11-point bulge with 9:02 left to the Crusaders.

Johns Hopkins

The Blue Jays finished fifth in the Pride of Maryland tournament, falling in the opener to Hood before rebounding with wins vs. Washington and Villa Julie ... **G Phil Beggans (Ocean, NJ / Ocean Twp.)** scored 17 points vs. the Blazers ... **F John Alberici (West Chester, PA / Malvern Prep)** scored 14 of his career-high 17 points in the second half as the Jays shot 57.6 percent in the final 20 minutes to down the Shoremen ... **F Kevin Roach (Derwood, MD / Magruder)** led JHU with 12 points and six boards vs. the Mustangs.

McDaniel

The Green Terror is 3-0 for the first time since 1986-87 after winning the Pride of Maryland tournament ... McDaniel won the title with an 85-84 three-overtime victory against Hood - the third 3-OT game in Conference history ... **F Brett Foelber (Sykesville, MD / Cardinal Gibbons)** scored 23 points vs. Hood and was named the tourney MVP ... **G Ryan Finch (Flemington, NJ / Hunterdon)** added 20 vs. the Blazers ... **F Chris Prior (Westminster, MD / Westminster)** had a double-double with 18 points and 15 rebounds in the semifinal win vs. Salisbury ... **F Chad Arrington (Randallstown, MD / Randallstown)** led the way with 23 points and 15 boards in the opener vs. Villa Julie.

Muhlenberg

The Mules fell on the road at Drew ... **G Ryan Foster (Newtown, PA / Council Rock North)** had 18 points on 7-of-9 shooting while **C Peter Barnes (Haddonfield, NJ / Haddonfield Memorial)** blocked seven shots - one shy of the school single-game record.

Swarthmore

C Ian McCormick (Seattle, WA / University Prep) scored a career-high 36 points with 12 rebounds in the OT loss at Arcadia ... **G Matt Kurman (Rockville, MD / Walter Johnson)** dropped in 17 points to go along with six assists.

Ursinus

The Bears had four players in double figures in rolling over Lebanon Valley ... **G Nick Shattuck (Ardsley, PA / La Salle)** had 19 points, while **G Matt Hilton (Lewistown, PA / Lewistown)**, **F John Noonan (Havertown, PA / Friends Select)** and **G Keith Page (Manchester, England / Blair Academy)** added 14, 12 and 10 points, respectively.

Washington

The Shoremen finished seventh in the Pride of Maryland tournament, knocking off Goucher in overtime as **G Tim Kohlrus (Fairfax, VA / W.T. Woodson)** scored a career-high 35 points ... Kohlrus made the game-tying free throws to force OT and the game-winning charity toss with :13 left in extra time ... he set a tournament record with 73 points in the three games.
