## Player of the Week

### Ian McCormick, Swarthmore

**Senior, Center, Seattle, WA (University Prep)** – McCormick averaged 23.5 points, 13.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 blocks in a 1-1 week. He had 29 points, 15 rebounds and three assists in the 72-57 win against Muhlenberg. McCormick followed that effort with 18 points, 11 boards, three assists and three blocks in a 69-55 loss at Gettysburg. He became the school's all-time rebounding leader (770) and is one point shy of the 1,500 mark for his career.

**Dickinson** .....Last 5: 2-3

The Red Devils went 0-2 vs. playoff-bound McDaniel and Ursinus ... Dickinson must beat Muhlenberg on Wednesday to keep its playoff hopes alive ... G **Kizmehr Grell (Laurelton, NY / The Gunner)** averaged 23.0 ppg. last week ... Dickinson has only shot better than 40 percent from the field in two of its last nine games.

**Franklin & Marshall** .....Last 5: 2-3

The Diplomats dropped two games last week but is still alive in the CC playoff chase ... C **James McNally (Bridgewater, NJ / Bridgewater-Raritan)** had his fourth double-double of the season with 21 points and 14 boards vs. Ursinus ... he averaged 22.0 ppg. and 10.5 rpg. in the two games ... F&M has Gettysburg and Dickinson at home this week ... the Dips are 199-41 at Maysers since 1994.

**Gettysburg** .....Last 5: 5-0

The Bullets clinched the No. 2 seed for the (19) CC tourney with wins vs. Hopkins and Swarthmore ... Gettysburg, ranked No. 2 in the Mid-Atlantic region, has won seven straight games and tied the 1960-61 squad for the second-highest victory total in school history ... the Bullets were 15-of-15 from the line vs. the Garnet ... G **Dan Capkin (Wynnewood, PA / Lower Merion)** is 29 points shy of 1,000 ... F **Joe Spierenburg (Chambersburg, PA / St. Maria Goretti, MD)** reset the Bullet record for blocks in a season (89).

**Haverford** .....Last 5: 2-3

The Fords went 2-0 last week, defeating Washington and Franklin & Marshall ... G **Mike Fratangelo (Pittsburgh, PA / Wilksburg)** averaged 17.5 ppg. in the two wins ... F **Brent Anderson (Cape May Courthouse, NJ / Middle Twp.)** registered a double-double with 16 points and 11 boards vs. the Shoremen ... the Fords shot 61 percent from the field in the second half and 58 percent for the game vs. the Diplomats ... G **Chaz Thomas (Huntington, NY / Wyandanch)** has a 13-game double-figure scoring streak.

**Johns Hopkins** .....Last 5: 3-2

The Blue Jays clinched their sixth straight Conference playoff berth with a win at Muhlenberg ... F **Kevin Roach (Derwood, MD / Magruder)** scored a career-high 17 vs. the Mules ... Hopkins needs just four wins to hit the 800-mark (796-899-1) ... the Jays have made a three-pointer in 314 consecutive games dating to Feb. 17, 1996 ... after starting the season 6-6, Hopkins has won eight of its last 11 contests.

**McDaniel** .....Last 5: 3-2

The Terror defeated Dickinson and Washington to secure its first Centennial playoff berth since 1995 ... the victory at Carlisle secured for McDaniel its first winning season since 1984-85 ... the Green and Gold can get a first-round tourney bye with a win against Hopkins on Wednesday ... F **Chris Prior (Westminster, MD / Westminster)** had 14 points and 16 rebounds vs. the Shoremen – his seventh double-double of the season ... coach **Kevin Curley** has led the Terror to 15 wins – just one shy of the CC record for first-year coaches (16, Kevin Small, Ursinus, 2001).

**Muhlenberg** .....Last 5: 2-3

The Mules dropped games to Swarthmore and Hopkins but still holds a game advantage for the final CC playoff berth ... 'Berg can lock up the spot with a win vs. Dickinson and an F&M loss to Gettysburg ... F **Ryan Foster (Newtown, PA / Council Rock North)** averaged 13.5 ppg. in the two games ... the three-game losing streak is the fourth of the season for the Mules, who have responded with a win the previous three times.

**Swarthmore** .....Last 5: 1-4

The Garnet went 1-1 last week, winning at home vs. Muhlenberg but falling on the road at Gettysburg ... C **Ian McCormick (Seattle, WA / University Prep)** became the school's all-time rebounding leader (770) with his 10<sup>th</sup> board vs. the Bullets ... he has 1,499 career points and will become the 14<sup>th</sup> CC player to reach the 1,500-point mark with his next basket ... McCormick has 11 double-doubles this season and 28 for his career ... F **Raul Ordonez (Miami, FL / Belen Jesuit Prep)** averaged 12.5 rebounds in the two games ... G **Matt Kurman (Rockville, MD / Walter Johnson)** is just 16 points away from the 1,000-point club at Swarthmore.

**Ursinus** .....Last 5: 5-0

The Bears, ranked 19<sup>th</sup> by *D3hoops.com* and 1<sup>st</sup> in the Mid-Atlantic region by the NCAA, made it 15 in a row with wins at F&M and Dickinson ... the win in Lancaster was the 136<sup>th</sup> for coach **Kevin Small**, making him the winningest coach in UC history ... Ursinus was 15-of-21 from beyond the arc vs. the Diplomats, including six from G **John Noonan (Havertown, PA / Friends Select)** and five from G **Matt Hilton (Lewistown, PA / Lewistown)** ... the duo had four triples apiece vs. the Red Devils ... Ursinus secured the top seed and homecourt for the CC final four on March 1-2.

**Washington** .....Last 5: 0-5

The Shoremen went 0-2 last week with losses to Haverford and McDaniel ... G **Alan Kines (Towson, MD / Towson)** scored a career-best 17 points vs. the Terror ... he averaged 15.5 ppg. for the week ... Washington is 0-14 when trailing at the half ... the Shoremen have outrebounded only two of 23 opponents this season.
