Player of the Week

Sarah Meisenberg, Franklin & Marshall

(Jr, G, Severna Park, MD / Severn School) – Meisenberg single handedly won two out of the three games for the Diplomats this week. She averaged 21.0 points, 6.7 rebounds and 5.3 assists, while scoring the game-winning baskets against Hopkins and Washington. Meisenberg shot 57.1 percent from the floor and became the 14th player in program history to reach 1,000 points vs. the Blue Jays. She hit the 20-point mark in each game for a team-leading 11th time this season. Meisenberg tallied 20 points and tied a career-high with nine rebounds to go with seven assists vs. the Shorewomen.

Bryn Mawr

The Owls fell in three CC games this week... **Jessica Allen (Reading, PA / Reading)** tallied two double-doubles on her way toward scoring 16 points per game and grabbing 29 total rebounds, and also scored 25 points in the OT loss to the Garnet...**Shanika Bridges-King (Roxbury, MA / English)** also recorded a double-double this week, with 15 points and 13 boards in the overtime contest while averaging eight points in the three games...**Emilie Naccarato (Valparaiso, IN / Wheeler)** led her team with 14 points against the Mules.

Dickinson

The Red Devils remain atop the CC standings by a full game after winning two conference games on the road...**Laura Houseal (Harleysville, PA / Souderton)** averaged 14.5 points and six rebounds per game, and recorded a double-double against the Bullets...**Carole Dempsey (Potomac, MD / Churchill)** scored 15 points in the win over GBurg to lead the team...**Brooke Muller (Northampton, PA / Whitehall)** averaged 11 points per contest and hauled in 10 total rebounds for the week...the Devils' class of '08 now has the most victories in school history with 78 triumphs.

Franklin & Marshall

The Diplomats went 2-1 in three road contests...**Sarah Meisenberg (Severna Park, MD / Severn)** was the savior in two games, scoring the game-winner against the Jays with 0:03 left and hitting the go-ahead basket with under a minute to help the team defeat the Shorewomen...she also scored her 1000th career point this week, averaging 21 points, 6.7 rebounds, and 5.3 assists, and remains near or at the top of several statistical categories...**Cara Landolfi (North Arlington, NJ / Montclair)** contributed 11.7 points per game...**Alison Menna (Scarsdale, NY / Scarsdale)** brought down a team season-high 14 rebounds against the Shorewomen.

Gettysburg

The Bullets lost to first-place Dickinson before defeating the Owls...**Courtney Fields (Baltimore, MD / St. Paul's)** averaged 11.5 points and 11 rebounds, including a double-double performance against Bryn Mawr...**Caitlin Moser (Wyomissing, PA / Wyomissing)** scored 27 points in the two contests to lead her team...the Bullets played stifling defense versus the Owls, holding them to 28 points on only 17% field goal shooting, and having a season-best +26 advantage on the glass.

Haverford

The Fords remain winless in conference play after dropping two CC matchups...**Brittany Lattisaw (Washington DC / Mercersburg Academy)** scored 27 of her team's 45 points against the Shorewomen...the 60% is the highest individual percentage this season in the CC... for the week, she averaged 19 points and 5.5 boards...**Erica Juliano (Lancaster, PA / Lancaster Catholic)** scored 16 total points for the Fords, including 10 against Hopkins.

Johns Hopkins

The Blue Jays lost a heartbreaker to the Dips before sweeping past the Fords...**Kristin Phillips (Wilmington, DE / Tower Hill)** averaged 14 points and nine rebounds, including a double-double performance against F&M...**Lyndsay Burton (Long Valley, NJ / West Morris Central)** chipped in 13 points per contest and picked up two steals in each game...**Andrea Dodrill (Baltimore, MD / Bryn Mawr)** added a double-double of her own in the F&M contest...14 different Jays saw game action against the Fords.

McDaniel

The Green Terror recorded two critical wins over F&M and UC to remain in the thick of the CC playoff race...**Ashley Lyles (Laurel, MD / St. Vincent Pallotti)** led the team in scoring and rebounding this week, with numbers of 13.5 and 8.5, respectively...she recorded a double-double in the win over the Dips...**Whitney Snoops (Millersville, MD / Archbishop Spalding)** contributed 10 points and 6.5 rebounds per game...Lyles and Snoops had identical tallies of 13 and 7 against Ursinus...**Robbin Gregg (Oakland, MD / Southern Garrett)** tied Lyles for the team lead against F&M with 14 points.

Muhlenberg

The Mules remain in second place in the CC standings with a strong showing against the Owls this week...**Sheila Cook (Rockville Centre, NY / Kellenberg Memorial)** had 18 points and two steals to lead her squad to victory...**Lauren Boyle (Wantage, NJ / High Point Regional)** grabbed a team-leading eight rebounds to go with 13 points...the 38 points allowed is a season-best for the Mules, who are only one game behind Dickinson with two weeks left before the CC playoffs.

Swarthmore

The Garnet won one and lost one at home this week, defeating Bryn Mawr in OT and losing to first place Dickinson...**Kathryn Stockbower (Ft. Washington, PA / Upper Dublin)** nearly recorded a triple-double against the Owls, going for her 16th double-double of 22 points and 18 rebounds while adding eight assists...she recorded #17 against the Devils, with 18 points and 11 snatches...she continues to lead the CC in rebounding with 14 per game...**Karen Berk (Havertown, PA / Haverford)** averaged 14 points and 8.5 rebounds of her own.

Ursinus

The Bears defeated Washington but lost to the Green Terror in two home contests...**Sarah Hennessey (Philadelphia, PA / St. Hubert's)** and **Jaclyn Hilf (Maple Glen, PA / Upper Dublin)** each scored 23 points in the victory to pace their team...Hennessey also played all 80 minutes this week for the Bears, averaging 17.5 points and 5.5 boards...**Carolyn Konstanzer (Hilltown, PA / Pennridge)** contributed 14.5 points per contest and grabbed eight rebounds in each game...the Bears have a tough week ahead, traveling to third place F&M and first place DC.
