PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Ryan Foster, Muhlenberg (Sr, F, Newtown, PA / Council Rock North)

Foster averaged 18.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in a pair of Mule victories vs. Haverford and McDaniel. He scored the team's first 13 points vs. the Fords and hit a three-pointer at the start of overtime to put 'Berg ahead for good vs. the Terror. Foster shot 50 percent from beyond the arc (6-12) and added five assists and four blocks on the week.

Dickinson

Junior **Matt Dolan (Chalfont, PA / St. Joseph's Prep)** scored 20 points, while classmate **Chris Harrington (Cheverly, MD / Georgetown Prep)** added 13 as the Devils broke a 15-game losing streak with a 74-61 win over Gettysburg. Sophomore G **Chris Heine (Spring Lake, NJ / St. Rose)** drained five three-pointers for 16 points in the loss to Haverford. Dickinson has received 40 starts from its freshman class this season - the second-highest total in the Conference.

Franklin & Marshall

The Diplomats remained a game in front of Ursinus and Muhlenberg for the top seed in the Conference with wins over Johns Hopkins and Swarthmore. Junior F **James McNally (Bridgewater, NJ / Bridgewater-Raritan)** averaged 16.5 points and 9.5 rebounds on the week. F&M is now 37-1 when leading at halftime over the last two seasons, and 34-2 when outrebounding its opponents. The Diplomats are also 30-3 at the Mays Center over the past two campaigns.

Gettysburg

The Bullets stumbled twice last week to fall from a tie for second place to a tie for fourth. Junior F **Kevin Kennedy (Gaithersburg, MD / Quince Orchard)** poured in 20 points in the home loss to Washington. Junior C **Andrew Powers (Boyertown, PA / Boyertown)** is now second on the all-time school list for free throws made (378) and attempted (508). He is also just the ninth Gettysburg player to record 100 career steals. The Bullets have made at least one three-point goal in 198 straight games dating to the 2002-03 season.

Haverford

Sophomore G **Ian Goldberg (Manhattan, NY / Poly Prep)** averaged 15.5 points in a 1-1 week, including a career-high 22 to give the Fords a season sweep of Dickinson. Senior G **Matthew Palmer (Seven Fields, PA / Sewickley Academy)** became the seventh Haverford player to make 100 career three-pointers (102). Junior F **Sam Permutt (Columbia, MD / Atholton)** is just two blocks shy of becoming the eighth Ford with 50 in a career.

Johns Hopkins

Senior G **Pat O'Connell (Baltimore, MD / Loyola Blakefield)** became the fifth Hopkins player with 500 points, 200 assists and 100 steals in a career. Head coach **Bill Nelson** is just seven wins shy of 500 for his career. Junior F **John Alberici (West Chester, PA / Malvern Prep)** scored a season-high 14 points vs. Ursinus. Freshman G **Mike Rhoads (Huntingdon Valley, PA / Chestnut Hill Academy)** tossed in a career-best 15 markers vs. Franklin & Marshall.

McDaniel

The Green Terror suffered costly CC losses to Swarthmore and Muhlenberg last week. Sophomore **Marcus Dyson (Scotch Plains, NJ / Union Catholic)** averaged 13.5 points and 8.0 rebounds in the two games, as McDaniel closed the month with a 2-7 mark. The Terror battled back from an 11-point second-half deficit to force overtime vs. the Mules.

Muhlenberg

The Mules started and ended the month with an overtime victory in Maryland - this time vs. McDaniel. The last time 'Berg won two OT games on the road in the same season was 1950-51. Senior **Ryan Foster (Newtown, PA / Council Rock North)** tossed in 20 points with seven boards and three blocks vs. the Terror. Sophomore F **Spencer Liddic (Clarks Summit, PA / Abington Heights)** posted his CC leading eighth double-double of the season with 11 points and 15 rebounds vs. Haverford. He leads all Centennial players with 58 offensive rebounds (3.1 per game).

Swarthmore

The Garnet made it three straight wins at Tarble Pavilion with a 60-48 triumph over McDaniel. Freshman F **Will Gates (Willeville, NY / Candor Central)** had another double-double with 17 points and 10 boards, while senior G **Matt Allen (Seattle, WA / Lakeside)** added 14 points and five assists. Gates averaged 19.5 points and 8.5 rebounds in a 1-1 week. Junior F **Sam Lacy (Jericho, VT / Mount Mansfield Union)** is now fourth on the all-time Swarthmore blocked shot list (69).

Ursinus

The Bears ran their win streak to six with wins over Washington and Johns Hopkins. Freshman F **Jon Ward (Allentown, PA / Parkland)** scored 22 points while senior G **Remy Cousart (Philadelphia, PA / Holy Ghost Prep)** added 12 points and 12 rebounds vs. the Shoremen. Ursinus collected a season-high 53 rebounds in the win. Cousart led the way with 19 points vs. the Blue Jays and is 25 points and two assists shy of 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 500 assists in his career. Junior G **Matt Hilton (Lewistown, PA / Lewistown)** has made 25 straight free throws. The Bears are 29-4 over the past three seasons at Helfferich Hall and host F&M on Wednesday night.

Washington

The Shoremen became just the third school in the Conference to win at Franklin & Marshall and Gettysburg in the same season with a triumph over the Bullets. It was Washington's fourth road win of the season - the most since 2002. Senior **Andrew Chambers (Williamsport, MD / St. Maria Goretti)** averaged 14.5 points and 4.0 assists in a 1-1 week. The Shoremen finished January with a 6-3 record - the best since going 6-3 in 2001.
