Dickinson

Sophomore G **Chris Heine** (Spring Lake, NJ / St. Rose) knocked down five threes for a career-high 23 points in a win at McDaniel. He is second in the Conference in 3-point percentage (43.9). Junior **Matt Dolan** (Chalfont, PA / St. Joseph's Prep) leads the team in scoring (12.3) and rebounding (8.1). Freshman **Chris Barsanti** (Hummelstown, PA / Tilton School, NH) is third in the CC in free throw percentage (82.9).

Franklin & Marshall

Junior F **James McNally** (Bridgewater, NJ / Bridgewater-Raritan) is second and third in the CC in scoring (17.4) and rebounding (8.1), respectively. Sophomore G **Georgio Milligan** (Spring Valley, NY / Don Bosco Prep) leads the Centennial in assists (4.70) and is second in steals (2.40). Junior F **Mike Baker** (Maryland Heights, MO / Whitfield School) tops the Conference in blocked shots (28). F&M was ranked fourth in the initial NCAA Mid-Atlantic regional rankings, trailing Albright, Lycoming and Cabrini. The Diplomats are now 14-1 when leading at halftime.

Gettysburg

The Bullets nearly set a Conference record, shooting 69.4 percent from the field in the win at Johns Hopkins. Junior C **Andrew Powers** (Boyertown, PA / Boyertown) averaged 18.5 points and shot 65 percent from the floor last week. He leads the Centennial in scoring (19.1). Freshman **Alex Zurn** (Brookeville, MD / St. Andrew's Episcopal) is second among CC rookies in scoring (11.2). Senior G **Brendan Hager** (Berwyn, PA / Conestoga) is third in the Conference in assists (4.60). The Bullets have made at least one three-point goal in 200 straight games dating to a loss at Navy on Dec. 14, 2002.

Haverford

The Fords broke the 80-point barrier in a regulation game for the first time since February 2006 with an 80-75 triumph at Washington. Junior F **Sam Permutt** (Columbia, MD / Atholton) had 20 points and 11 rebounds, giving Haverford the season sweep. He is fifth in the CC in rebounding (7.3). Freshman G **Cam Baker** (Columbus, OH / Columbus Academy) leads the Centennial in steals (2.88).

Johns Hopkins

Sophomore F **Danny Gergen** (Austin, TX / Anderson) was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District II second team. He is averaging 6.9 points and 2.8 rebounds per game and has a 3.85 GPA in history. The Blue Jays' tilt at Swarthmore was postponed until Feb. 15. Senior **Andrew Farber-Miller** (Charlottesville, VA / St. Anne's Belfield) is fourth in the CC in field goal percentage (52.1). Senior G **Pat O'Connell** (Baltimore, MD / Loyola Blakefield) is second in the Conference in steals (2.40) and fifth in assists (3.50).

McDaniel

The Green Terror losing streak reached four with defeats at the hands of Johns Hopkins and Dickinson. Sophomore **Marcus Dyson** (Scotch Plains, NJ / Union Catholic) averaged 10.5 points in the two games. McDaniel is now 1-6 since losing **Louis Sarris-Grau** (Huntingdon Valley, PA / Lower Moreland) for the season with an injury.

Muhlenberg

Sophomore F **Spencer Liddic** (Clarks Summit, PA / Abington Heights) had a huge game in the win over Swarthmore with career-highs in points (24) and rebounds (19). He is averaging 17.0 points and 13.8 rebounds over the Mules' last eight games. Liddic was also named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District II second team. Senior **Ryan Foster** (Newtown, PA / Council Rock North) is third in the CC in three-point field goals (40).

Swarthmore

Freshman F **Will Gates** (Willeysville, NY / Candor Central) and senior G **Matt Allen** (Seattle, WA / Lakeside) combined for 38 of the Garnet's 50 points in the loss at Muhlenberg. Gates is fifth in the Conference in scoring (15.6) and ninth in rebounding (6.8). Freshman **Jordan Martinez** (Oakdale, NY / Episcopal, VA) is second among all CC rookies in assist-turnover ratio (1.17).

Ursinus

The Bears had their six-game win streak snapped by #15 Franklin & Marshall. Senior G **Remy Cousart** (Philadelphia, PA / Holy Ghost Prep) had a memorable game in the loss at Gettysburg, scoring his 1,000th career point and handing out his 500th career assist. Junior G **Matt Hilton** (Lewistown, PA / Lewistown) is fourth in the CC in scoring (15.8) and leads the Conference in three-point (46.3) and free throw percentage (96.9). He has a streak of 29 consecutive free throws made.

Washington

The Shoremen dropped the season set to Haverford with an 80-75 home loss to the Fords. Sophomore **Kevin Breslin** (Hagerstown, MD / St. Maria Goretti) had a career-best 22 points. He is second among Conference free throw shooters at 85.2 percent. Senior **Andrew Chambers** (Williamsport, MD / St. Maria Goretti) is the CC's third-leading scorer at 16.5 ppg.
