The Diplomats won their fifth Conference championship with wins over Muhlenberg and Gettysburg. G **Anthony Brooks (Orlando, FL / Lake Mary)** averaged 17.5 points in the two wins, while C **Mike Baker (Maryland Heights, MO / Whitfield School)** posted 12.5 points and 10.5 rebounds in the victories. Sophomore G **Georgio Milligan (Spring Valley, NY / Don Bosco Prep, NJ)** is the first guard to ever lead the CC in blocked shots (38). F&M went wire-to-wire this season, earning the preseason favorite nod from the coaches and SIDs. It is the fifth straight year that the preseason poll picked the Centennial champion and sixth in the last seven seasons.

The Bullets reached the Conference final for the third straight season but fell at Franklin & Marshall, 66-62. Senior G **Brendan Hager (Berwyn, PA / Conestoga)** set a Centennial tournament record with 11 assists vs. Washington and 20 for the tournament. He is the first Gettysburg player to lead the Conference in assists (5.46). C **Andrew Powers (Boyertown, PA / Boyertown)** poured in a game-high 28 points in the championship game. He is sixth on the Gettysburg all-time scoring list with 1,426 points. Powers is the first Gettysburg player to lead the Centennial in scoring (19.3) since **Bill Davidson** in 2000.

The Bears were ousted from the Conference tournament after a first-round home loss to Muhlenberg. Senior G **Remy Cousart (Philadelphia, PA / Holy Ghost Prep)** is the only player in Centennial history with more than 1,000 points (1,052), 700 rebounds (779) and 500 assists (526). He finished his career second in Conference history in assists and ninth in rebounding. Freshman C **Jon Ward (Allentown, PA / Parkland)** is just the third freshman in CC history to lead the Conference in field goal percentage (65.7). Junior G **Matt Hilton (Lewistown, PA / Lewistown)** is the first player in CC history to lead the league in three-point FG percentage (44.9) twice.
