### Bryn Mawr

The Owls gave Dickinson all it could handle for 40 minutes before succumbing 60-54 in Carlisle. Sophomore **Lindsey Darvin (Gladstone, NJ / Bernards)** led the way with a game-high 22 points, while senior **Shanika Bridges-King (Roxbury, MA / English)** had her eighth career double-double with 12 points and 15 rebounds. Bridges-King and junior **Emilie Naccarato (Valparaiso, IN / Wheeler)** combined for 31 of BMC's 33 points vs. Washington.

### Dickinson

The Red Devils need one win and one Washington loss to secure a Centennial playoff berth for the sixth straight season. Junior F **Alesha Sisco (Effort, PA / Blair Academy, NJ)** ranks in the top 10 in the CC in scoring (13.8) and rebounding (7.6). Classmate **Carole Dempsey (Potomac, MD / Winston Churchill)** ranks in the top five in field goal (48.0) and free throw (78.8) percentage.

### Franklin & Marshall

Junior G **Beth Holt (Lancaster, PA / Lancaster Catholic)** had a steal and a blocked shot in the final five seconds in the win at Ursinus. She finished with 13 points and four assists. Freshman **Alexa Barbush (Etters, PA / Trinity)** is fourth in the CC in free throw percentage (78.6) and third in steals (3.20).

### Gettysburg

The Bullets registered their 19th win of the season with a victory over Ursinus. The only Gettysburg teams to win more games were in 1984 (22-4) and 1995 (20-5). Soph **Julie McGrory (Moorestown, NJ / Moorestown)** averaged 17.0 points in a 2-0 week with a 20-point effort vs. Haverford. Senior **Courtney Fields (Baltimore, MD / St. Paul's School for Girls)** tallied 16 of her 19 points in the second half in the comeback win at Hopkins. Senior G **Allie Drechsler (Westminster, MD / Winters Mill)** is six steals shy of the school single-season mark of 76. Junior F **Caitlin Moser (Wyomissing, PA / Wyomissing)** is fourth in the CC in scoring (14.4).

### Haverford

Freshman G **Nina Voith (Philadelphia, PA / Germantown Friends)** posted her fifth double-double of the season with 21 points and 10 rebounds vs. Washington. She ranks in the Conference top 10 in scoring (17.7) and rebounding (6.8). Classmate **Victoria Sobocinski (Southampton, NJ / Bishop Eustace)** ranks seventh in 3-point percentage (38.0). Senior **Sara Cram (Redding, CT / Joel Barlow)** set a career high with 15 caroms vs. the Shorewomen.

### Johns Hopkins

Junior F **Lyndsay Burton (Long Valley, NJ / West Morris Central)** posted her fifth double-double of the season with 15 points and 12 boards vs. Gettysburg. She is currently 115 points shy of the 1,000-point mark for her career and surpassed the 500-rebound plateau (502) vs.

the Bullets. Burton is second in the CC in field goals percentage (53.2).

### McDaniel

McDaniel is just three wins shy of the all-time Conference record for consecutive victories following wins over Swarthmore and Dickinson. The Terror, winners of 16 in a row, holds the mark of 19 straight victories in 2006-07. Senior G **Ali Moreland (Davidsonville, MD / South River)** became the 14th member of the school's 1,000-point club vs. the Devils and now has 1,017 points. Senior G **Sally Grace (Catonsville, MD / Mount de Sales Academy)** is now fourth in school history in three-point goals (104). She is second in the CC in 3-point percentage (43.2). Freshman G **Katelyn Fischer (Reisterstown, MD / Seton Keough)** leads all Centennial guards and is fifth overall in FG percentage (47.1).

### Muhlenberg

The Mules won two more last week to improve to 45-6 in their last 51 Centennial regular-season games. 'Berg's defense led the way vs. Dickinson, holding the Red Devils to just 23.6 percent shooting and 41 points. Sophomore G **Alexandra Chili (Rockville, MD / Walter Johnson)** is now second on the school's career three-point field goal list with 159. She leads the Centennial in scoring (18.5) and threes (63). Muhlenberg was ranked fifth in the first NCAA Mid-Atlantic regional rankings. Junior G **Kelly McKeon (Watertown, CT / Holy Cross)** tops the Conference in assist-turnover ratio (2.23) and is seventh in rebounding (7.3).

### Swarthmore

Junior F **Kathryn Stockbower (Fort Washington, PA / Upper Dublin)** became just the second Centennial player to register 60 double-doubles in a career with a 15-point, 15-rebound effort vs. nationally-ranked Muhlenberg. She has scored in double figures in a CC-record 68 straight games and is now just 41 rebounds shy of 1,000. Stockbower was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District II first team. Soph **Genny Pezzola (Oakland, CA / St. Mary's College HS)** leads the Conference in three-point FG percentage (43.5).

### Ursinus

The Bears went 1-2 last week with a win over Bryn Mawr between losses to F&M and Gettysburg. Sophomore F **Lindsay Teuber (Philadelphia, PA / St. Basil's)** averaged 14.3 points and 7.3 rebounds in the three games, including a 19-12 effort vs. the Diplomats. Classmate **Ryann Burke (Haddon Twp., NJ / Haddon Twp.)** scored 12 points vs. the Bullets.

### Washington

The Shorewomen kept their playoff hopes alive with a pair of wins last week. Junior G **Jessica Jamrogowicz (Marlton, NJ / Bishop Eustace)** nearly had a triple-double with 10 points, 11 assists and eight rebounds vs. Bryn Mawr. Freshman **Erin Kile (Benton, PA / Benton)** posted her fifth double-double with 17 points and 11 rebounds vs. Haverford.
