Centennial Notebook

Ursinus made it six championships in a row in convincing fashion, defeating Haverford (10-2) and Johns Hopkins (6-0). **Megan Yoder (Lititz, PA / Lancaster Mennonite)** scored three times and added an assist vs. the Fords, while **Michelle Wimmer (Palm, PA / Upper Perkiomen)** had a hat trick vs. the Blue Jays. The three-goal efforts tied the Conference single-game playoff record, set by Johns Hopkins' **Ashlee Duncan** in 2003.

The Bears will host a NCAA four-team regional this weekend in Collegeville. Ursinus will take on the winner of Wednesday's Lynchburg/Juniata game on Saturday. UMass-Dartmouth, Middlebury and Trinity are on the other side of the bracket.

Ursinus sophomore **F Alyssa Thren (Barto, PA / Upper Perkiomen)** scored twice in the semifinal win over Haverford to become the third player in Centennial history to score 30 goals in a season. She is one away from tying the Conference single-season record.

NCAA Division III Championship Field

The Field Hockey Championship provides for a 24-team tournament. As required by the Division III selection principles, the following berths have been allocated for the 2009 championship: Pool A—16; Pool B—2; and Pool C—6.

After the determination of the automatic (Pool A) berths, the committee will determine the Pool B selections followed by the Pool C selections. **The Centennial Conference champion receives a Pool A berth.**

Pool B will comprise independent institutions and institutions that are members of conferences that do not meet the requirements for automatic qualification. Pool C will be reserved for institutions from automatic-qualifying conferences that are not their conference champions, and the remaining teams in Pool B.

Berths from Pool B and Pool C will be selected on a national basis, using regional selection criteria. There will be no predetermined regional allocations for Pools B and C.
