Offensive Player of the Week

Ryan Murray, Franklin & Marshall

(So, RB, Sebastian, FL / St. Edward's) – Murray rushed for a school-record 240 yards and five touchdowns as the Diplomats closed the year with a 56-38 win against Gettysburg. Four of his five scores came in the fourth period and Murray became the first runner to gain over 100 yards against the Bullets in 12 games.

Defensive Player of the Week

Brandon Doyle, Muhlenberg

(Jr, CB, New Providence, NJ / New Providence) – Doyle and his secondary mates held Moravian's Marc Braxmeier to just 7-of-24 passing for 95 yards in the Mules' 35-7 win. Braxmeier entered the game as the CC's top-rated passer (149.9). Doyle had an interception, three pass-breakups and an interception.

Special Teams Player of the Week

Richard Hill, Johns Hopkins

(Sr, DB, Huntington Station, NY / St. Anthony's) – Hill made his collegiate finale a memorable one, taking the opening kickoff 90 yards for a touchdown in the Blue Jays' 31-3 win at McDaniel. It is the first and only kickoff return of Hill's career.

Game Preview: The Mules and the Sea Gulls meet for the first time in the first round of the NCAA tournament ... Muhlenberg closed out an undefeated regular season with a 35-7 win over archrival Moravian ... it was the first unbeaten regular season for the Mules in 106 years of football ... the victory tied a school record with 'Berg's 10th win of the season and extended its school-record winning streak to 11 ... QB **Eric Santagato (Ringwood, NJ / Lakeland)** completed 15 of 19 passes for a career-high 297 yards and two TDs vs. the 'Hounds ... his scoring passes covered 19 yards to TE **Matt Johnson (Lancaster, PA / Lancaster Catholic)** and three yards to WR **Phil Cresta (Aston, PA / Sun Valley)** ... Santagato leads the Conference in passing efficiency (155.17) with 13 TD passes and just four interceptions ... Johnson set three records in the game, boosting his season total to a school-record 42 catches for a Centennial record 662 yards and a 'Berg mark with six TDs ... RB **John DeLuca (Sayville, NY / Sayville)** rushed for 133 yards for his seventh 100-yard performance ... he has 1,267 yards on the season – good for fourth on the Mule single-season chart – and needs 140 to break the school record ... Muhlenberg's defense shut down the Greyhounds and QB Marc Braxmeier, who entered the game as the CC leader in pass efficiency, holding him to just 9-of-24 completions for 95 yards with two picks ... LB **Dustin Good (Pottstown, PA / Pottsgrove)** had a team-high eight tackles, while DL **Chris Musselman (Lambertville, NJ / South Hunterdon)** had a sack to raise his career total to 22 – a half-sack shy of the school record ... Muhlenberg is making its fourth trip to the NCAAs, all since 2002 ... the Mules defeated UMass-Dartmouth at home in the first game but have dropped three straight since to John Carroll (2002 second round), Christopher Newport (2003) and St. John Fisher (2004) ... 'Berg is one of seven undefeated teams in Division III, joining Mount Union (Ohio), Central (Iowa), St. Norbert (Wis.), Case Western Reserve (Ohio), Washington & Jefferson (Pa.) and Curry (Mass.) ... Salisbury closed out a 9-1 regular season with a 35-14 victory over Frostburg in the Regents Cup game in Annapolis ... the Sea Gulls set a school record with 418 points in 10 games and have won their nine games by an average of 27.4 points with the lone defeat coming at the hands of Wesley on the road, 20-13 ... Salisbury is averaging over 340 yards rushing per game, headlined by QB **Ronnie Curley** who leads the option offense with 751 rushing and 463 passing yards with 14 TDs ... WR **Kevin Tillage** has 18 catches for 413 yards with five scores.

Game Preview: The Red Devils finished the regular season with a 35-20 triumph against Ursinus ... RB **Michael D'Amico (Wilmington, DE / Wilmington Friends)**, who has been slowed by injuries in his senior season, broke out with a season-high 127 yards and two TDs ... QB **Ian Mitchell (Newtown Square, PA / Malvern Prep)** ran for 126 yards and scored a touchdown while also throwing for two TDs to WR **Patrick O'Connor (Exton, PA / Downingtown East)** ... Mitchell has 823 rushing yards on the year and is 100 shy of the Conference single-season mark ... he leads the CC in interception avoidance (1.493), throwing just three picks in 201 attempts ... LB **Eric Dube (Voorhees, NJ / Eastern)** set a school single-season (132) and career record (579) for tackles ... WR **Chris McInerney (Philadelphia, PA / Chestnut Hill Academy)** leads the CC with 7.6 receptions per game and 154.9 all-purpose yards per outing ... Dickinson is second in the Conference in rushing offense (196.6) and defense (110.5) ... DB **Michael Maxwell (Coatesville, PA / Coatesville)** shares the Centennial lead in interceptions (5), while secondary mate **Ryan Heinig (Jenkintown, PA / Jenkintown)** leads in passes defended (14) ... Waynesburg is coming off a convincing 54-13 victory against Westminster in its regular season finale ... RB **Robert Heller** has rushed for over 2,000 yards this season, gaining 2,019 on 344 carries with 26 TDs ... the Devils (17-13) and the Jackets (27-23) have one common opponent - Grove City.

Game Preview: The Bullets ended the regular season with a 56-38 loss at Franklin & Marshall ... Gettysburg finished with a 6-4 record – its first winning season since 1995 ... the defense had its streak of 11 straight games without allowing a 100-yard rusher snapped by F&M ... Gettysburg leads the Conference in rushing (254.7) for the fifth time in the last six years and in total offense (420.3) for the second straight season ... the Bullets paces the CC in third-down conversion percentage (42.4) and sacks allowed (11) ... RB **Tom Sturges (Ridgefield, CT / Ridgefield)** had a disappointing end to his season, suffering an injury after only four carries vs. F&M ... Sturges leads the Conference for the third straight season in rushing, gaining 1,431 yards with 12 TDs ... he has 4,173 career yards on 909 carries ... **Jamel Mutunga (Bel Air, MD / Bel Air)** came off the bench and rushed for 114 yards and two TDs ... freshman **Charles Curcio (Hammonton, NJ / St. Joseph)** was third in the CC in punt (11.1) and kickoff (23.1) returns ... PK **Josh Huson (McLean, VA / McLean)** leads the Conference in kick-scoring with 66 points ... he has 143 points in his career – good for seventh on the Centennial career list ... QB **Matt Flynn (Northfield, NJ / Mainland)** is one of just three Conference QBs to throw for over 3,000 yards (3,045) in his first two seasons ... it is the first-ever ECAC Bowl game for the Bullets and first trip to the postseason since the 1985 NAAs ... the Tartans knocked off Washington & Lee, 39-21, to close the regular season at 6-4 ... RBs **Travis Sivek (1,033)** and **Robert Gimson (1,007)** each went over the 1,000-yard mark for the season.

Franklin & Marshall (4-6)

The Diplomats closed the 2007 season with a three-game winning streak, capped by a 56-38 victory against Gettysburg ... RB **Ryan Murray (Sebastian, FL / St. Edward's)** set a school single-game record by rushing 40 times for 240 yards with a CC- record-tying five touchdowns ... it was Murray's second 200-yard effort in three games and surpassed the old mark of 232 yards set by **Andy Surtz '97** against Hobart in 1996 ... the five rushing TDs shattered the old standard of three, while the 40 carries was the second-highest total in school history ... the 1,023 yards of total offense between the two teams is the fifth-highest total in Conference history ... the 56 points put on the board by F&M is the most since a 59-13 win against Georgetown in 1984 ... QB **Kyle Turner (Haddonfield, NJ / Haddonfield)** led the Conference with 19 TD passes ... he closes his career in third place on the school charts in completions (393), yards (4,773) and touchdowns (37) ... WR **George Eager (Lititz, PA / Manheim Twp.)** led all CC receivers with 70 receptions and was second in yards (764) and TDs (8) ... WR **Jay Ridinger (Lititz, PA / Manheim Twp.)** led all rookie receivers with 42 catches for a CC freshman record 519 yards and six TDs ... LB **James Gregory (Rockville, MD / Churchill)** was third in the Centennial with 87 tackles ... the Diplomats were the most-penalized team in the CC with 533 yards on flags ... Franklin & Marshall returns 16 starters from its final two-deep in 2008.



Johns Hopkins (4-6)

The Blue Jays registered their seventh straight victory against McDaniel with a 31-3 triumph in Westminster ... Hopkins has not allowed more than nine points to the Terror since 2001 ... the Jays' 4-6 mark was the first losing season since 1999 (4-6), but keeps alive the streak of winning at least four games in each of coach **Jim Margraff's** 18 seasons ... RB **Andrew Kase (Wyomissing, PA / Wyomissing)** rushed for 227 yards to tie a school single-season record with his sixth 100-yard rushing effort of the season ... he closed the year with 1,009 yards – the second-best total in JHU history ... Kase is one of just three 1,000-yard rushers in the CC this season ... DB **Richard Hill (Huntington Station, NY / St. Anthony's)** made his first and only kickoff return one to remember as he returned the boot 90 yards for a touchdown ... it was the first KOR for a score by a Hopkins player since 1995 ... WR **Corey Sattler (Monroeville, PA / Gateway)** closed his career in ninth place on the Hopkins career list in catches (97) and yards (1,383) ... PK **Alex Lachman (Livingston, NJ / Livingston)** finished the year 23-of-23 on extra points and 11-of-12 on field goals, setting a Conference single-season record for field goal percentage (91.7) ... he is one of just five CC players to make all of his extra point kicks (min. 20) in a season ... Hopkins led the CC in red-zone offense, scoring on 92.6 (25-of-27) chances inside the 20 ... DB **Dan Requena (Fairlawn, NJ / Fairlawn)** shared the CC lead in interceptions (5) ... LB **Colin Wixted (Lafayette Hill, PA / St. Joseph's Prep)** was second in the Conference with 16.5 tackles for loss ... Hopkins played the toughest schedule in the Centennial in 2007, as its 10 opponents had a combined winning percentage of 58.5 percent.



Juniata (1-9)

The Eagles broke a nine-game losing streak and sent their seniors out on a winning note with a 56-38 win against Gallaudet ... TB **Kyle McKechnie (Shillington, PA / Gov. Mifflin)** ran for a career-high 181 yards and three TDs, as Juniata rushed for 306 yards – the first 300-yard performance by the Eagles since 2003 ... QB **Jay Leonard (Newville, PA / Big Spring)** threw for 282 yards and three TDs, while WR **Lance Tippett (Altoona, PA / Altoona)** was on the scoring end of all three aerials and had 131 yards on the day ... LB **Josh Roy (Fredericksburg, PA / Northern Lebanon)** picked off a pass and returned it 68 yards for his first career touchdown ... he was second in the Conference with 105 stops ... Leonard, who set a Centennial single-season record with 419 attempts, led the CC with 2,360 passing yards and now has 5,669 through three seasons ... he needs 547 yards in his senior season to become the all-time leader at Juniata ... Tippett led all Centennial receivers with 1,012 yards and 10 TDs on 54 receptions ... P **Tyler Templeton (Ebensburg, PA / Central Cambria)** was second in the CC with a 38.0 average on 58 punts ... Juniata was the least penalized team in the Conference as the Eagles were flagged 35 times for 274 yards.



McDaniel (1-9)

The Green Terror closed its worst season since 1988 with a 31-3 home loss to Johns Hopkins ... McDaniel finished ninth in the Conference in scoring offense (13.2) and defense (34.1) ... RB **Eric Zwilsky (Knoxville, MD / Brunswick)** led the team in rushing (527) for the second straight season ... he is the first Terror back to do that in his freshman and sophomore seasons since **Eric Frees '92** in 1988-89 ... WR **Matt Bergbauer (Westminster, MD / Westminster)** topped the receiving chart with 36 catches, while **Brian Amenta (Baltimore, MD / Perry Hall)** gathered in 35 aerials ... Bergbauer's 36 grabs was the most by a Terror WR since **Teron Powell '02** in 2001 ... DB **Travis Wenrich (Wernersville, PA / Conrad Weiser)** shared the Conference lead with five interceptions and topped the league in punt return average (14.1) ... QB/P **Tom Wenrich (Wernersville, PA / Conrad Weiser)** led the Centennial in punting (38.7) and closed his career as the school's all-time leader with a 38.26 yard average on 121 kicks ... DL **Bryan Letourneau (Damascus, MD / Damascus)** was second in the CC with 7.0 sacks.



Moravian (6-4)

The Greyhounds' first game against archrival Muhlenberg as a member of the same Conference since 1982 ended with a 35-7 loss ... Moravian finished at 6-4 for the 17th winning season in coach **Scot Dapp's** 21 seasons ... the 'Hounds allowed the fewest yards per punt return in the CC (2.0) ... Moravian was ninth in the Conference in red-zone defense, allowing points on 92.5 percent (37-of-40) of trips inside the 20 ... QB **Marc Braxmeier (Center Valley, PA / Allentown Central Catholic)** threw 17 TD passes on the season – good for second place among Centennial throwers and the second-best single-season total in 'Hound history ... WR **Sean Hill (West Reading, PA / Wyomissing)** was second among Centennial receivers with eight TD catches ... WR **Shawn Sylvania (Nazareth, PA / Nazareth)** was second in receiving yards (466) by a freshman in the CC ... DB **Carl Robinson (Boothwyn, PA / Garnet Valley)** shared the Conference lead with five interceptions ... PK **Brian Reckenbeil (Branchburg, NJ / Somerville)** booted an extra point to extend his streak to 38 consecutive PATs ... he closed the season 29-of-29, becoming one of just five Centennial kickers to go a season without a miss (min. 20) ... LB **Drew Morrissey (Emmaus, PA / Emmaus)** led the Conference with four fumbles forced.



Ursinus (7-3)

The Bears dropped their season finale at Dickinson by a 35-20 count ... UC's 4-1 road record is the best by the Collegeville 11 since 2000 ... QB **Nicholas Dye (Glenside, PA / Cheltenham)** threw 16 TD passes on the season – the third-highest single-season total at the school, while his 1,803 yards of total offense was also the third-best season total ... DB **Ryan Van Wright (Moorestown, NJ / Moorestown)** led the Conference in kickoff return average (26.9) and was second in punt return average (11.9) and interceptions (4) ... DB **Chris Frank (Blue Bell, PA / Plymouth-Whitemarsh)** led the Centennial with 18 tackles for loss ... Ursinus was second in the CC in scoring (15.7) and total defense (270.8) ... the Bears led the Conference in red-zone defense, allowing points just 57.7 percent of the time (15-of-26) inside the 20.
