OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Tyler McCambridge, Moravian (Sr, RB, Northampton, PA / Allentown Central Catholic) – McCambridge carried 14 times for 162 yards and scored three touchdowns as the Greyhounds defeated McDaniel, 42-3. His scoring runs covered 37, nine and four yards and he surpassed the 1,500-yard mark for his career (1,537).

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Doug Bocchino, Moravian (Sr, DL, Madison, NJ / Madison) – Bocchino helped anchor a Greyhound defense that allowed just 30 passing and 113 total yards in the 42-3 win at McDaniel. He registered six tackles, including 2.5 for losses and 1.5 sacks.

Preview: It's the battle for the **Conestoga Wagon Trophy** as the Diplomats and the Red Devils meet for the 100th time in a series that began in 1889 ... it is the 1,000th NCAA game played by Dickinson and the school's first home night football game ... F&M holds a 26-19-1 series lead in Carlisle but has not won at Biddle Field since 1998 (26-23) ... the Diplomats dropped a 14-7 decision at Catholic last week ... **QB John Harrison (Flourtown, PA / La Salle)** completed 20 of 34 passes for 216 yards, including a 7-yard TD strike to WR **George Eager (Lititz, PA / Manheim Twp.)** ... 12 of his completions went to Manheim Twp. grads, as Eager pulled in seven passes and **Jay Ridinger (Lancaster, PA)** had five catches for 43 yards ... LB **Zach Romash (Haddonfield, NJ / Haddonfield)** led the defense with 12 tackles, while DB **Jeff Kellar (State College, PA / State College)** had eight stops and an interception ... the Diplomats held the ball for nearly 36 minutes vs. CUA ... the Devils dropped a 28-21 contest at Hobart ... RB **Greg Lord (Wyomissing, PA / Wyomissing)** went over the 100-yard mark for the second straight week (19-106) and scored twice ... QB **Ian Mitchell (Newtown Square, PA / Malvern Prep)** tossed a 20-yard scoring strike to WR **Pat O'Conner (Exton, PA / Downingtown East)** to give Dickinson a 21-14 lead with 4:31 left ... O'Conner had six catches for 101 yards on the day, while Mitchell accounted for 238 yards, incouiding 176 through the air ... DL **Tredell Johns (Paulsboro, NJ / Paulsboro)** had five solo tackles among his seven stops, including 1.5 sacks.

The Conestoga Wagon Trophy was instituted in 1963 as a symbol of the rivalry between the schools ... encased in glass, the Wagon was hand-carved by two Amish woodcarvers from Lancaster County and is a miniature replica of the wagon used to transport the players between the two schools when they first met on the field of play in 1889.

Preview: The Bullets and the Blue Jays meet for the 36th time in a series that began in 1911 ... it's Homecoming Weekend at Gettysburg ... Hopkins has won six of the last seven games at the Battlefield, but Gettysburg won the last meeting in 2006 by a 23-18 count ... Johns Hopkins improved to 2-0 with a wild 39-31 triple-overtime victory at Randolph-Macon – the Jays' eight straight road-opening win ... it was the second 3OT game for JHU and first since a 13-7 loss at Dickinson on Nov. 1, 1997 ... Hopkins is 2-2 all-time in extra periods ... freshman QB **Hewitt Tomlin (Jackson, TN / Trinity Christian)** got the start and responded by going 19-of-39 through the air for 195 yards and three TDs ... after scoring three touchdowns vs. St. Lawrence, the Blue Jay defense added another vs. R-MC as freshman **Tyler Brown (Huntington Station, NY / Walt Whitman)** sacked the QB, forced a fumble and returned it 22 yards for the score ... DB **Chris Baldwin (Southampton, NJ / Bishop Eustace)** had a career-high 12 tackles and forced a fumble vs. the Jackets ... RB **Andrew Kase (Wyomissing, PA / Wyomissing)** rushed for 95 yards and the game-winning TD in the third OT period ... Gettysburg lost a 45-40 shootout with Hampden-Sydney last week ... the Bullets amassed 475 yards of total offense, but surrendered 643 to the high-powered Tiger "O" ... TB **Jamel Mutunga (Bel Air, MD / Bel Air)** tied his career best with 114 yards and a touchdown ... QB **Matt Flynn (Northfield, NJ / Mainland Regional)** threw for 164 yards, while WR **Gavin Jablonski (Allenwood, NJ / Wall)** had four catches for 76 yards ... S **Joe Delaney (Voorhees, NJ / Eastern Regional)** led the defense with 13 tackles.

Preview: The Eagles and the Bears meet for the 14th time in a series that began in 1922 ... JC has won the last four meetings in Collegeville (1952-54-56-77) ... Juniata fell to 0-2 on the season with a heart-breaking 10-3 loss at Susquehanna ... JC failed to score on four tries inside the SU 5-yard line with under three minutes to play ... the Eagles' only points were set up by a 56-yard kickoff return by **Brandon Spayd (Huntingdon, PA / Huntingdon)** which led to a 24-yard FG by **Dan Zentz (Lutherville, MD / Calvert Hall)** ... QB **Jay Leonard (Newville, PA / Big Spring)** threw for 214 yards, making him the second JC quarterback to surpass 6,000 career yards (6,089) ... DL **Jason Marquis (Jeannette, PA / Jeannette)**, a co-captain along with heralded Ohio State recruit Terrelle Pryor on last season's state championship team, led the defense with seven solo tackles ... the Bears dropped their home opener to Lebanon Valley, 31-19 ... QB **Nick Dye (Glenside, PA / Cheltenham)** completed 17-of-27 passes for 213 yards and two TDs, while running for another 28 yards and a score ... WR **Shea Wisler (Green Lane, PA / Upper Perkiomen)** had six receptions for 87 yards ... Ursinus was hampered by eight fumbles, four of which were lost ... LB **Nate Mast (Manheim, PA / Manheim Central)** and DB **DeVohn Butler (Swedesboro, NJ / St. Augustine Prep)** each had nine stops for the defense.

RB Eric Zwilsky (Knoxville, MD / Brunswick) ran for 65 yards to lead the offense ... PK Jay Leonard (Westminster, MD / Westminster) booted a 38-yard field goal for the team's lone points ... the Terror had two TDs called back on penalties ... LB Mike Weick (Holland, PA / Penn Charter) led the defense with a game-high 12 tackles, while DB Travis Wenrich (Wernersville, PA / Conrad Weiser) made 11 stops ... Catholic improved to 2-0 with a 14-7 home win against Franklin & Marshall ... QB Keith Ricca completed 13 passes for 154 yards and two TDs, including a 63-yarder to Miles Sabrick for the game-winning points ... RB Greg Brown ran for 125 yards to lead the ground attack.

RB Tyler McCambridge (Northampton, PA / Allentown CC) ran for 162 yards and three TDs on just 14 carries ... RB Tyler deRouen (West Milford, NJ / W. Milford) carried 19 times for 93 yards, while Ryan Rempe (Dickson City, PA / Mid-Valley) picked up 66 on 10 totes ... QB Marc Braxmeier (Center Valley, PA / Allentown CC) completed 9-of-13 passes for 108 yards and two TDs ... the defense held the Green Terror to just 30 passing and 113 total yards ... LB Kevin McGorry (Whitehall, PA / Allentown CC) had seven tackles, while DL Doug Bocchino (Madison, NJ / Madison) had six tackles and 1.5 sacks ... Preview: The Mules and the Dutchmen meet for the ninth time ... Muhlenberg was idle last week, after a season-opening 34-21 win against Wilkes ... 'Berg was ranked eighth in last week's d3football.com poll ... QB Eric Santagato (Ringwood, NJ / Lakeland Regional) completed 18 of 26 passes for 308 yards and three TDs – a lofty 206.8 efficiency rating ... it was the first 300-yard game by a 'Berg QB since 2000 ... WR Phil Cresta (Aston, PA / Sun Valley) caught seven passes for 152 yards, including a 32-yarder for a score ... RB John DeLuca (Sayville, NY / Sayville) carried 33 times for 167 yards, giving the Mules a 100-yard rusher, a 150-yard receiver and a 300-yard passer in a game for the second time in program history ... it was DeLuca's 11th career 100-yard effort ...
