Around the Conference

CENTENNIAL RANKS THIRD

AMONG NATION'S CONFERENCES:

According to *LaxPower*, the Centennial Conference is third among 17 conferences in the website's power ratings. The Conference was 41-28 (.594) in non-Centennial games this season - good for fourth overall - with a power rating of 84.65. Only the NESCAC (89.90) and the Upstate Collegiate Athletic Association (84.93) were higher.

MOST IMPROVED: Haverford and Muhlenberg are among the top 15 most improved teams in the country, according to *LaxPower*. The Fords finished 9-8 this spring after compiling a 3-11 mark in 2002. Only Rosemont - which went from one win to 11 - had more improvement in the win-loss column. Haverford's power rating rank also improved by 32 spots to No. 43 overall, bettered only by Fredonia State's leap of 34 spots. Muhlenberg improved its power ranking by 21 spots, ranking 14th among all DIII schools.

MEGAN MURPHY: What a year for the senior from Wilton, CT. Murphy is one of just three Centennial players and 14 in Division III to score 90 or more goals in a season, while she is one of four players in DIII to score 130 or more points in a year.
