## Quick Sticks

The Centennial Conference season faces off on Saturday with a dandy as undefeated Haverford travels to the Battlefield to face undefeated Gettysburg. The Bullets are 24-1 all-time against the Fords, but Haverford's victory came last season by a 6-5 count.

Gettysburg's 9-5 triumph against Denison gave head coach **Hank Janczyk** his 300<sup>th</sup> career victory. He is just the third men's lax coach in NCAA history to reach the plateau, joining Army's Jack Emmer and Salisbury's Jim Berkman.

Haverford's 14-13 overtime triumph against #4 Lynchburg was the second time in two seasons that the Fords have defeated a top-5 opponent. Haverford toppled then No. 2 Gettysburg, 6-5, in last season's Centennial opener. **Dean Granoff (Wynnewood, PA / Friends Central)** scored the game-winning goal vs. the Hornets.

Swarthmore is 2-0 for the first time since 2002 following a 9-8 win vs. Merchant Marine – a 2007 NCAA tournament team. The Garnet started 6-0 in 2000.
