Quick Sticks

Three of the four playoff berths are locked up with Gettysburg, Washington and Haverford guaranteed spots in next Friday's semifinals. Ursinus and Muhlenberg meet Saturday in Collegeville with the winner advancing to their first-ever semifinal appearance opposite the second-ranked Bullets.

Washington senior **Chris Read (Baltimore, MD / Boys' Latin)** became just the eighth player in Conference history to amass 150 career goals with his five-goal effort vs. Franklin & Marshall.

Swarthmore GK **Frank Mazzucco (Redding, CT / Joel Barlow)** became just the 11th keeper in Conference history to surpass the 600-save mark. He now has 618 – good for ninth place overall.

Muhlenberg set a school record with its eighth victory in the 8-4 triumph vs. Montclair.

McDaniel looks to avoid its first-ever winless Conference slate when it plays host to Dickinson on Saturday.
