**LANCASTER, Pa. -- August 19, 2003** – Johns Hopkins, who will look to add a fourth crown to its credit while defending its title from last season, is favored to take to the top spot in 2003 according to the head women's soccer coaches in the Centennial Conference.

The Blue Jays received six out of a possible 11 first-place votes (teams not permitted to vote for themselves) for 96 points in the annual preseason poll of coaches. Hopkins dropped a hard-fought 1-0 loss to Stevens Tech in the first round of the NCAA Tournament in 2002, finishing the season at 14-6-2 overall and 7-2-1 in the Conference. All-Conference selections **F Meg McIntosh**, **M Kathleen Turley** and **B Laura Bauer** return to help guide the Blue Jays back to the Centennial and the NCAA tournaments. **Turley** and **McIntosh** were top point-getters for JHU last season. **Turley** netted eight goals with four assists for 20 points, while **McIntosh** tallied nine goals for 18 points.

Gettysburg and Muhlenberg were named the second and third choice, respectively, with 88 and 85 points and two first-place votes apiece. The Bullets knocked the regular-season champion Mules out of the Centennial Conference tournament in a semifinal battle, winning by a 1-0 double-overtime decision before losing to Hopkins (3-0) in the title game.

Franklin & Marshall was fourth with 74 points and one first-place vote. Haverford and McDaniel followed in fifth and sixth place with 55 and 53 points, respectively. The Green Terror lost 3-1 to Widener in the first round of the ECAC tournament in 2002, while the Diplomats defeated LaRoche, 5-0, and then won 4-1 over Widener for the ECAC title. F&M will have to fill the graduation void of two-time Centennial Player of the Year Heather Rice this season.

Dickinson (52), Swarthmore (45), Ursinus (24), Washington (20) and Bryn Mawr (10) rounded out the poll.

The 2003 season kicks off Friday, August 29, with Muhlenberg taking on St. Joseph's (NY) in the first day of action at the Kean Invitational.
