**Coach of the Year** – Sean Topping, Muhlenberg

**Notes**

- Antonini is the second Muhlenberg player to earn Player of the Year honors, following in the footsteps of Tim Averell (1995). He becomes the first sophomore in the 17-year history of the Conference to win the award. Antonini is one of two unanimous first-team selections by the Conference's 10 head coaches along with Bukoski.
- Bukoski becomes the 14th player to earn All-Centennial first team honors three times.
- Bukoski, Menge and Corsini are repeat first-team choices from 2008.
- Johns Hopkins has the most first-team selections (45) in the 16-year history of the Conference, followed by Gettysburg (42). Muhlenberg is next with 34 with Franklin & Marshall (19), Haverford (13), Dickinson (13), McDaniel (12), Swarthmore (6), Washington (6) and Ursinus (2) trailing.
- Six students were also named to the Conference Academic Honor Roll, which recognizes sophomores, junior and seniors who are key performers and have a 3.40 cumulative grade point average or higher.
