Top Individual Performances

Mike Pattanite, Gettysburg (So, 285, Tablenacle, NJ / Holy Cross) - Pattanite finished fourth at the Brute-Adidas Invitational hosted by Ursinus on Saturday to wrap up a 4-2 week. He also won a pair at a tri-match on Wednesday at King's, winning by matching 3-2 scores.

Dave DeGaravilla, Johns Hopkins (Sr, 285, Downingtown, PA/Downingtown) - DeGaravilla helped lead JHU to a 2-1 record this weekend, as the Blue Jays kicked off their Centennial slate.

Troy McGuinness, Kings Point (Fr, 174, Warrenton, VA / Fauquier) - McGuinness was 3-1 on the week, and 3-0 in Centennial Conference matches. Included in his three-match sweep in Saturday's quad match at Muhlenberg were pins against Nick LaFronz-Emberger of Stevens (4:26) and Peter Garry of Johns Hopkins at the second-period buzzer. The freshman then scored a 10-4 decision over Muhlenberg's Frank Pepe.

Drew Reinecker, McDaniel (Gr/Sr, 285, York Springs, PA / Bermudian Springs) - Reinecker went 3-0 at the Virginia Duals with a pair of 4-1 decisions and a forfeit improving his record to 6-1 on the season

Matt Loesch, Muhlenberg (So, 197, Carsonville, PA / Upper Dauphin) - Loesch won all four of his bouts during the week, extending his dual-meet winning streak to 16. Among Loesch's win were two pins and a 10-1 major decision. He also took a 5-0 decision against Johns Hopkins in a rematch of last year's CC 197-pound final.

Ryan Bennick, Stevens (Fr, 165, Jim Thorpe, PA / Jim Thorpe) - Bennick went undefeated on the week for the Ducks with a 15-0 victory over Hunter College in Tuesday's dual match. Against Centennial Conference competitors, he went 3-0 on Saturday, earning one win by pin and one by a major decision. Bennick improved to 19-9 overall and 7-1 in dual matches and is second on the team with four pins and four major decisions.

Mike Troutman, Ursinus (Jr, 174, Exeter, PA / Exeter) - Troutman captured his fourth tournament title of the season, posting a 4-0 record at 184. He needed less than a minute to record a victory in each of his first three bouts. In the finals, he defeated Jon Neyerlin of Wilkes 4-3 in overtime. This title marks Troutman's 14th collegiate championship.

Jesup Sataloff, Washington & Lee (Fr, 174, Baltimore, MD / McDonogh) - Sataloff went 2-0 at the W&L Invitational to win the 174-pound weight class. Sataloff, the number two seed, had a first round bye before winning his next two matches by major decision. He knocked off third-seeded Zach Padgett of Cumberland, 9-0, and then defeated top-seeded Matt Smith of Washington & Jefferson, 14-3, to claim the championship title.
