Top Individual Performances

Matt Shank, Gettysburg (Fr, 141, Reedsville, PA / Indian Valley) - Shank went 4-0 on the week, leading the Bullets to a 3-1 week. Shank raised his record to 28-5 with the wins, including his team-leading 10th pin of the season and first technical fall of his collegiate career.

Dave DeGaravilla, Johns Hopkins (Sr, 285, Downingtown, PA / Downingtown) - DeGaravilla recorded a pin in the Blue Jays' dual match with Ursinus.

Danny Song, Kings Point (Jr, 149, Holbrook, NY / Hauppauge) - Song went 3-2 on the weekend at the N.Y. State Collegiate Wrestling Championships, and his fifth-place finish was the highest for the seventh-place Mariners. Song captured the fifth-place bout with a 4:51 pin over Niagara County's Larry Aceti. He was one of six Mariners who were named All-State (top-eight in each weight class), and USMMA scored the third-best Division III finish at the meet (Brockport State, Oneonta State).

Jeremy Hart, Muhlenberg (Sr, 149, Hackettstown, NJ / Hackettstown) - Hart's second pin of the season helped the Mules to a 31-16 victory at Albright.

Pat Falvey, Stevens (133, Randolph, NJ / Randolph) - Falvey improved to 14-9 overall and 8-2 in dual matches with his fourth win by fall over Victor Ramirez of Centenary College on Wednesday evening. Falvey has won eight of his last 10 matches for the Ducks.

Eddie Murray, Ursinus (Jr, 125, Lancaster, PA / Lampeter-Strasburg) - Murray remained undefeated in dual-meet action, improving to 30-0 with two wins this week. He defeated Jim Van Daniker (JHU) 2-1 in double overtime and posted a win by forfeit against Baptist Bible.

CLOSING IN ON HISTORY: Gettysburg's **Matt Shank** (Fr, Reedsville, PA/Indian Valley) continues his strong rookie campaign, pacing the Bullets in wins (28) and pins (10). With eight matches remaining before the conference tournament, Shank is quickly closing in Jake Dell's freshman record of 34 wins (1994-95) and has an outside shot to reach the Gettysburg record for wins in a season (Dell, 40, 1997-98).

STORMING ALONG: Before a 40-3 loss to York in Saturday's final match, the Bullets ran off four straight wins – their longest such streak since a three-day span in 1997-98 when the squad defeated five consecutive conference foes. The culmination of the 2004-05 run came in the form of a 24-23 victory over Messiah, marking Gettysburg's first win against the Falcons since a 22-21 win on Jan. 27, 2001 and only the second win in the last 11 meetings.
